

### Curbside Pickup

Place library items on hold with your library card and pick up when ready!

**Step 1:** Call us at 724-226-3491 or email us at [clavharrisonlibrary@gmail.com](mailto:clavharrisonlibrary@gmail.com) to place a hold. Delivery service is not available at this time. Not sure what you want? Tell us what you like and we'll pick something for you!

**Step 2:** You will receive notification when holds are ready to be picked up. You can schedule a time to get your materials online or by calling the library.

**Step 3:** Your order will be placed in a brown paper bag with your name on it and placed in the lobby on your day of pick up.

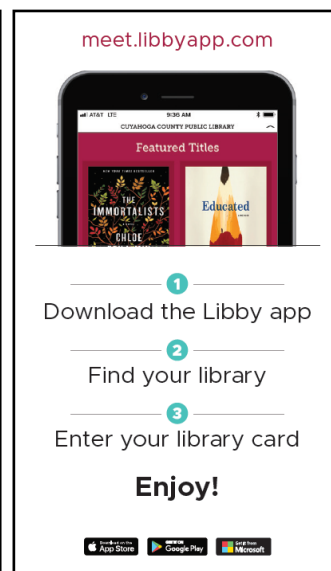
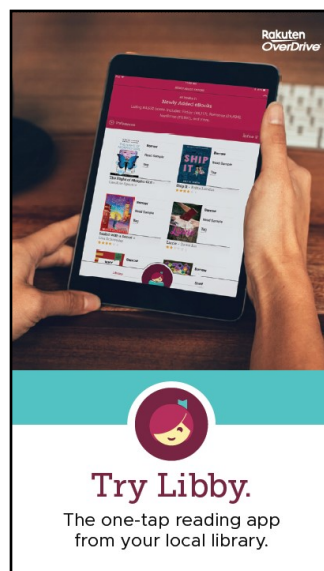

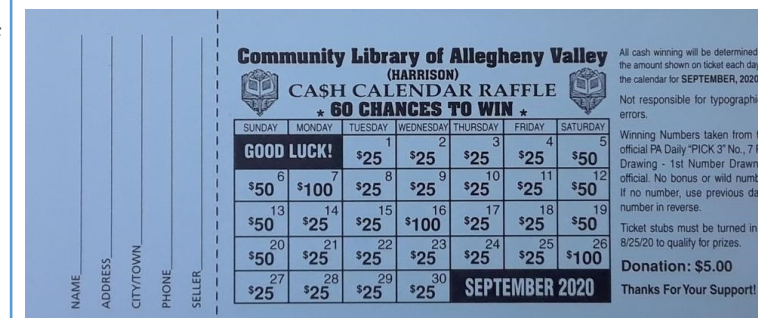

The Community Library of Allegheny Valley is pleased to announce the welcome addition of a specialized Local History Department to enhance the library's regular collection.

Originally, the local history collection was housed in the library's Tarentum branch. When the Tarentum branch closed in February, plans were made to relocate the entire collection to the Harrison library. By the end of March, all materials had been painstakingly moved and meticulously housed in the former space of the Harrison library's book sale materials.

Local History Department resources include:

- Over 1,400 books with special emphasis to our local areas.
- Nearly 1,200 rolls of microfilm of local newspapers
- Genealogy resources including:
  - Ancestry Library edition (in library use only)
  - Genealogy books and periodicals
  - Church histories and records
  - County and family histories
  - Funeral home and Cemetery records
  - Obituary indexes
  - High School yearbooks
  - and more!

The Local History Department staff is available to answer questions, provide research guidance and help in finding materials. Other services available include:
