Returns can be placed in our books drop. (Returned items will be quarantined for 4 days and will still appear on your account. You will not be charged any fines for this period.)

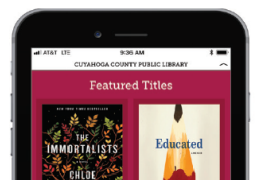
Mad Science Fire and Ice

Saturday November 14th, 1:00 pm

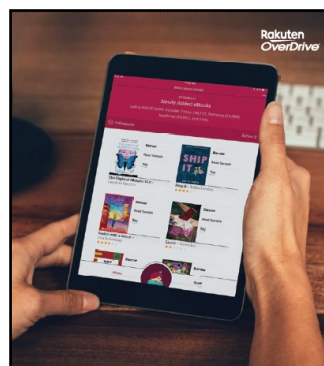
