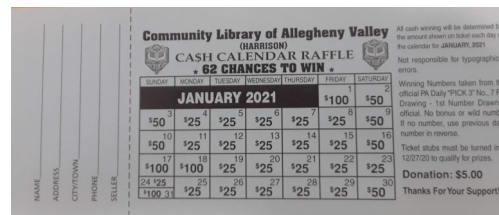

Winning numbers taken from the official PA Daily "PICK 3" No. 7 PM drawing - 1st number drawn is official.

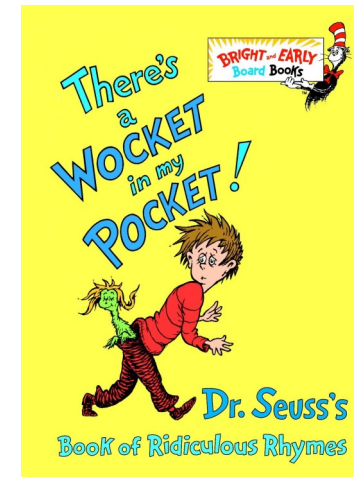
