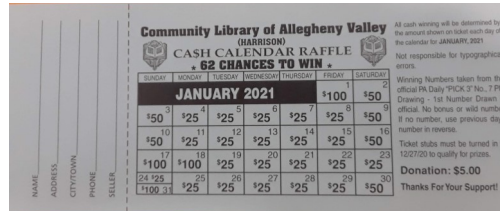


## ONLINE HOLDS

Beats: The Teen Technology Show (Zoom)

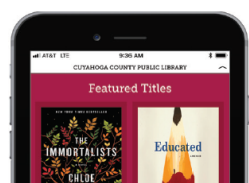

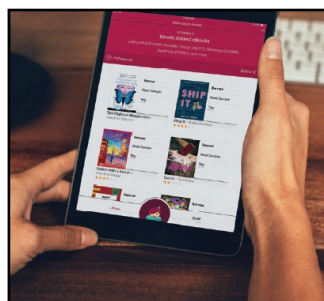

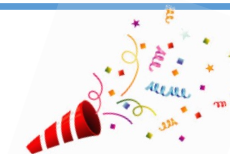
All Ages!, Sensory/Autism-Friendly Show

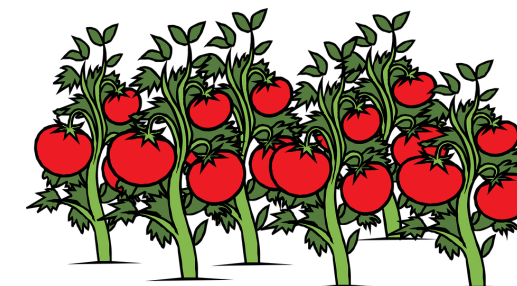
