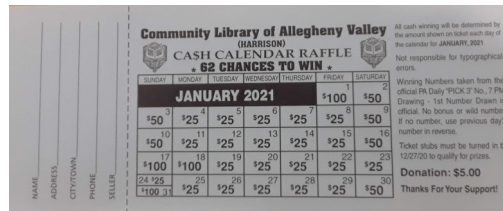


ONLINE HOLDS

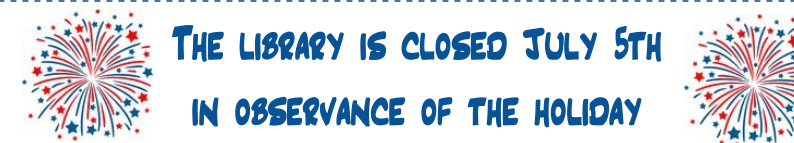

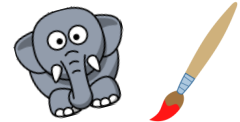
Stage Right Presents: The Rainbow Colored Fish: Wed, July 7th at 6:30pm—7:30pm

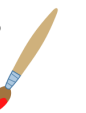
