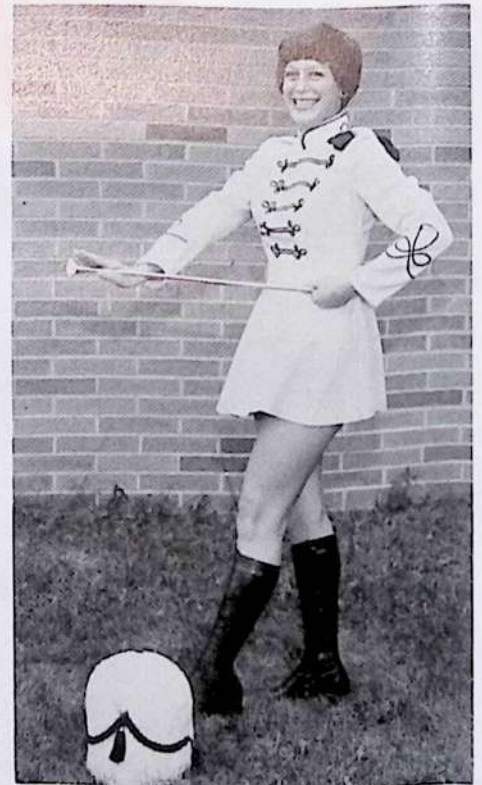

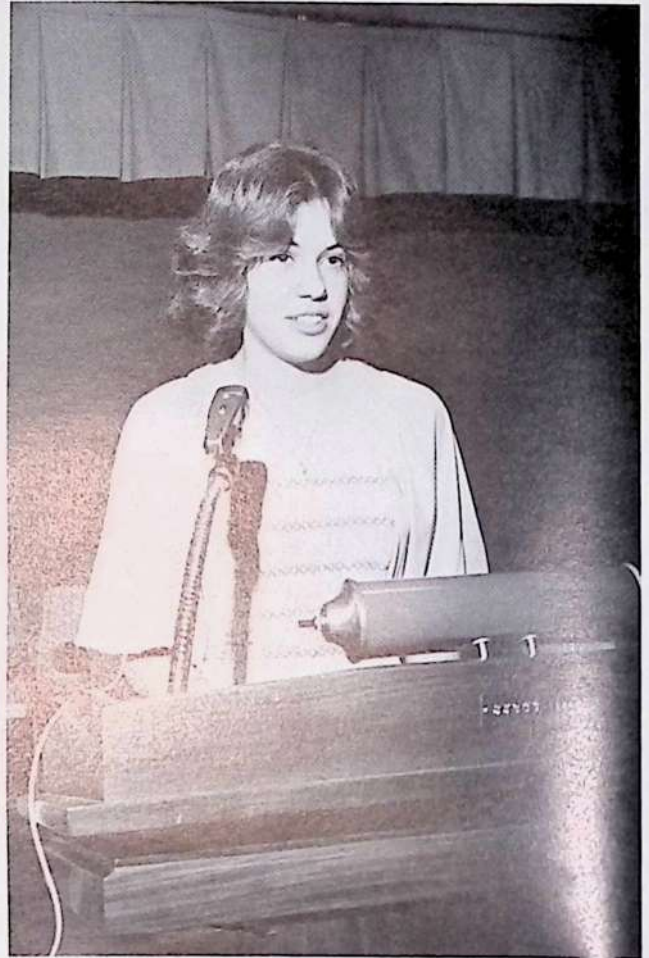

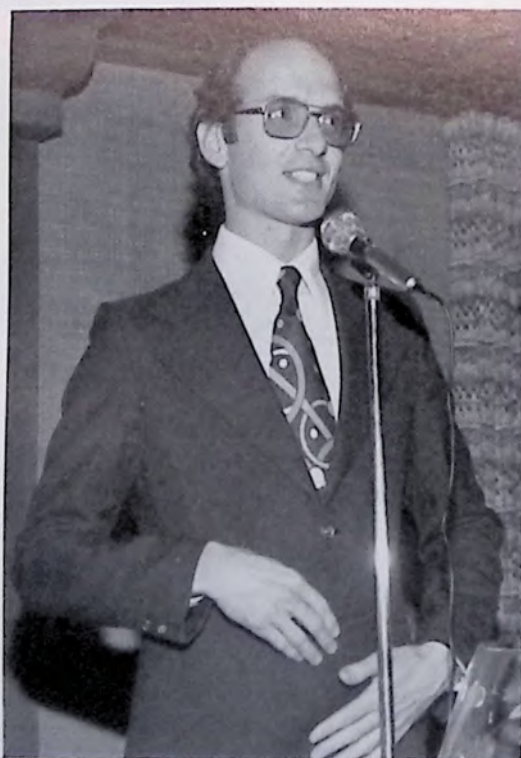

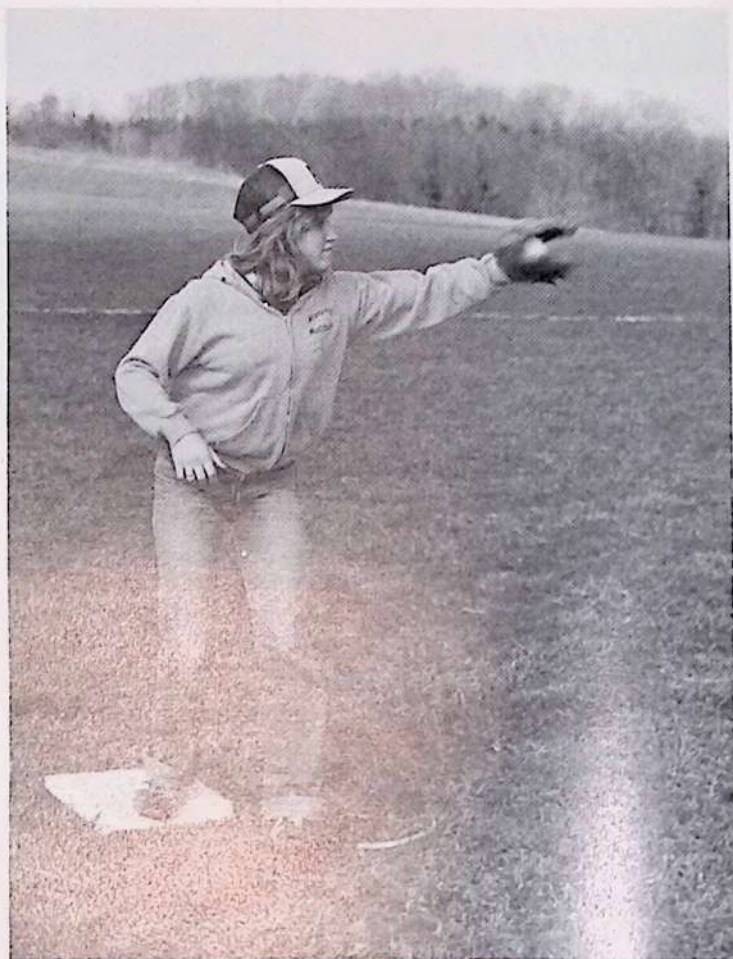

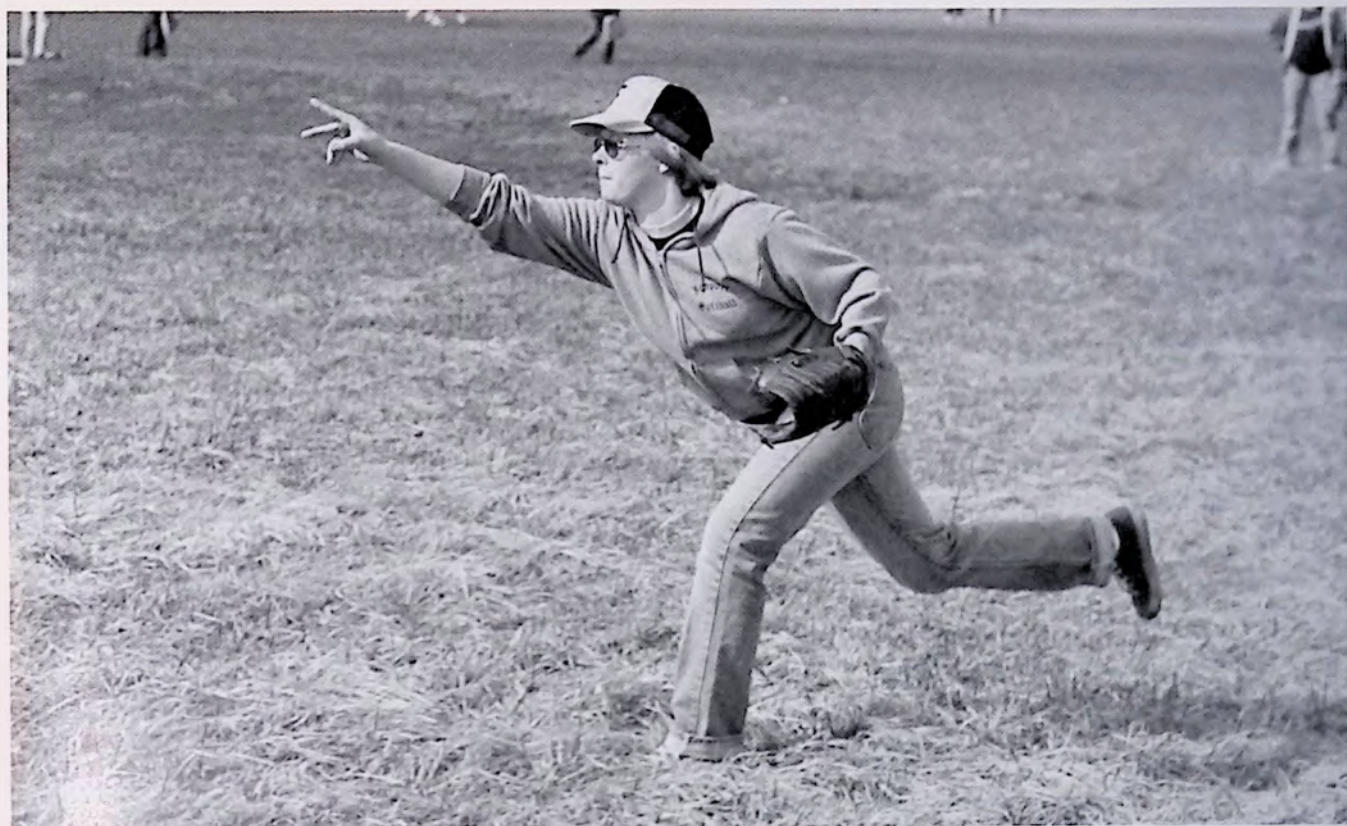

The 1978 Yellow Jacket Track Team did a commendable job this year running away with eight victories including the A.I. C. Championship at Richland High School by scoring 70 points. Bill Affrica walked off with the Most Valuable Trackman Award by breaking the school's half-mile record and dropping the 880 yard run record to 1:59.1. Seven track team members made the South Western Honor Roll. Bill Affrica was commended for his performance in the 440-yard dash and the 880-yard run with times 52.5 and 1:59.1, respectively. Pole vaulting of 12 feet 2 inches earned Mike Troup his place in the honor roll. Excellent performances were given by both Mike Troup and Greg Kropf throwing the discus: Greg with 148 feet 2 inches and Mike with 144 feet 1 inch. Barry Hinderleter was awarded sixth place after much hard work and dedication by running the 2-mile run in 10:11.3. The W.P.I.A.L. Class AA competition ended in success for the Yellow Jackets. Bill Affrica completed the 880-yard run in 2:00. Greg Kropf placed second in the discus throw tossing it 138 feet. Mike Sample came in fifth place with a 135 foot fling. The javelin was thrown 165 feet by junior Greg Balicki, who finished fifth place. Bill Affrica, Tim Brozenick, Chris Huth, and Pat Wood took second place with 3:31 in the one-mile relay. Junior Scott Camerlo placed third by running the mile in 4:42. The Yellow Jackets won a triangular meet involving Valley and Richland High School on March 28. Senior Bill Affrica annexed four first places including two relays with his faithful team of juniors: Brozenick, Huth, and Wood.

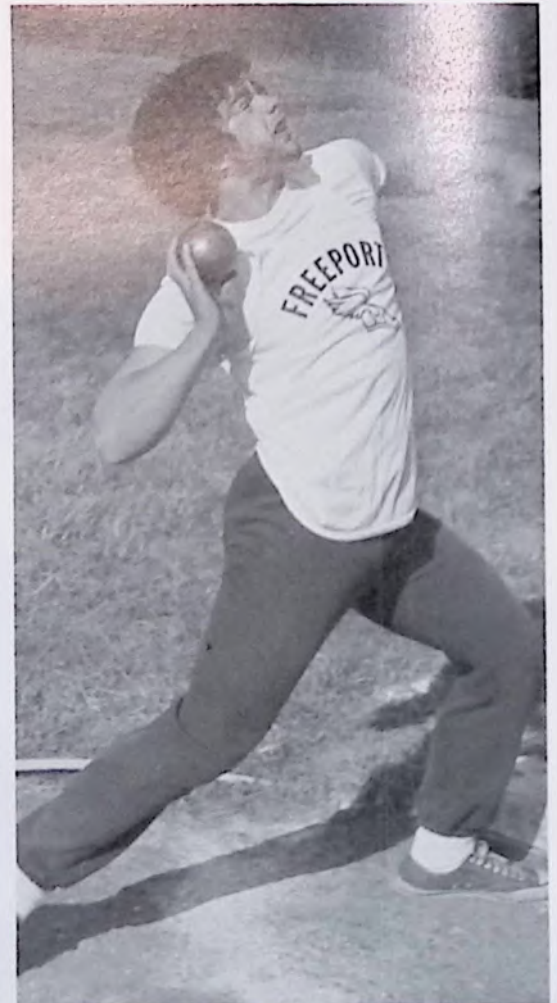

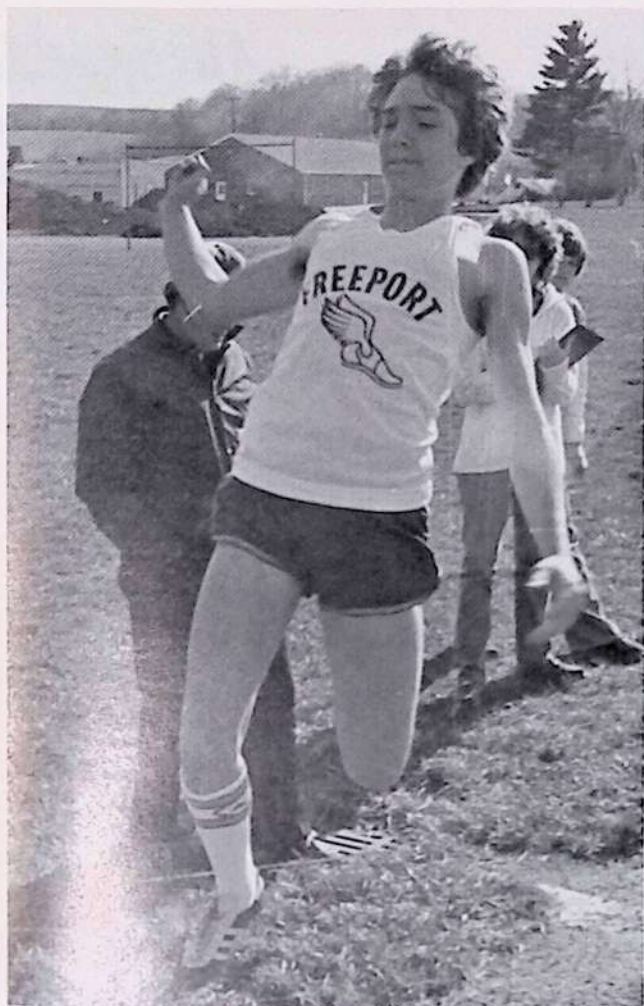

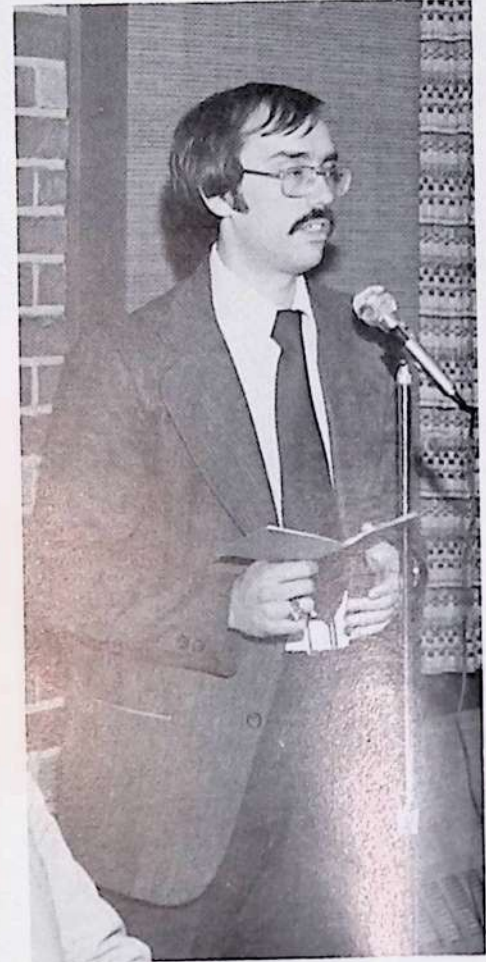

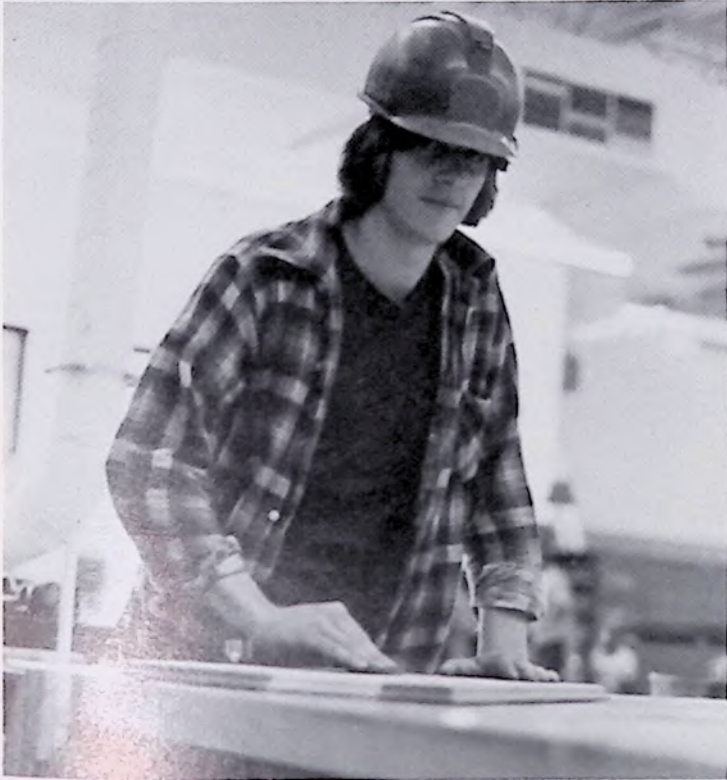

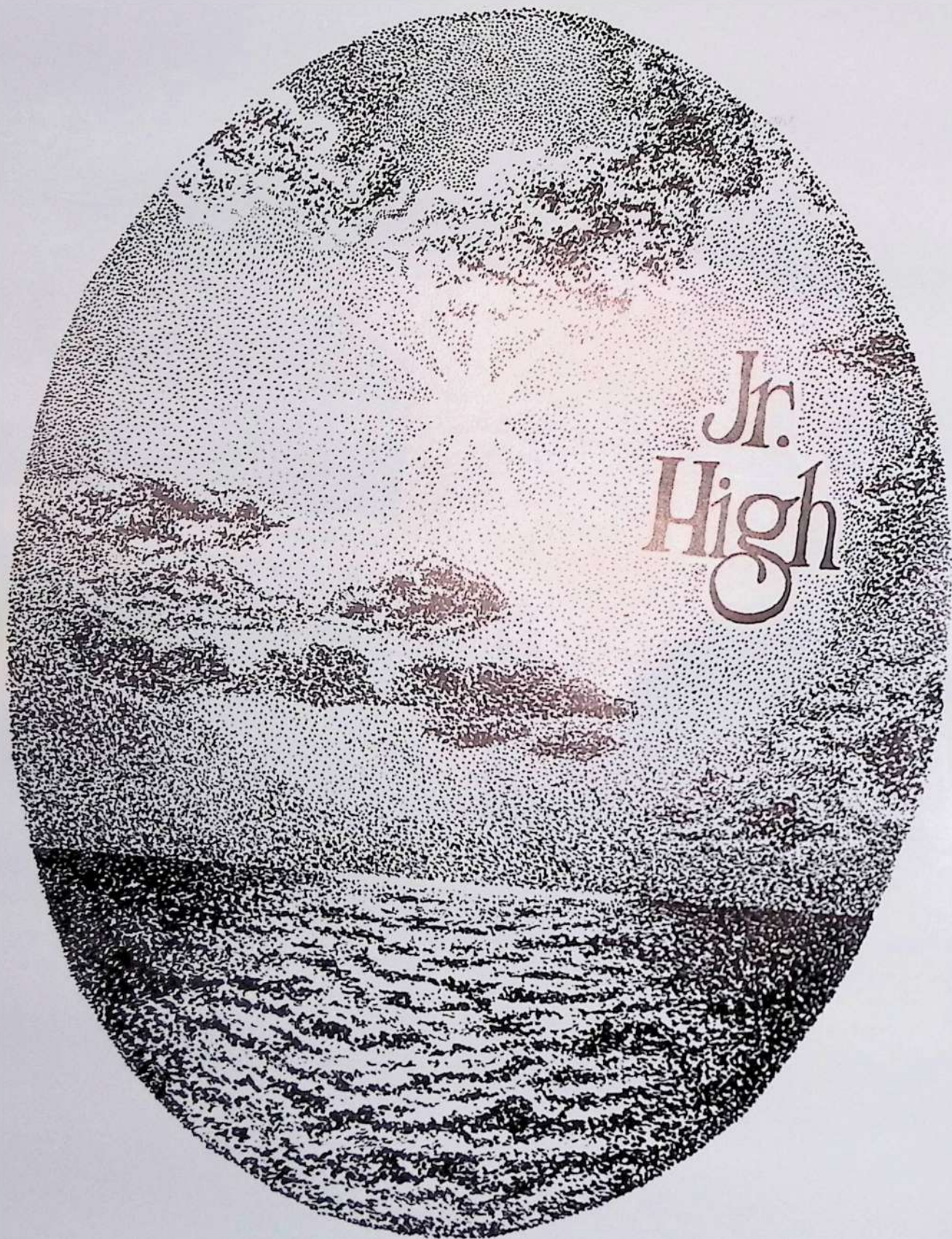

180 Seniors

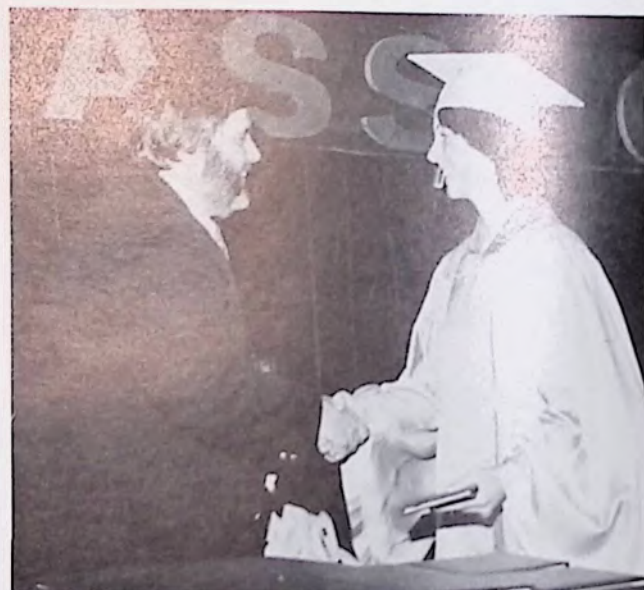

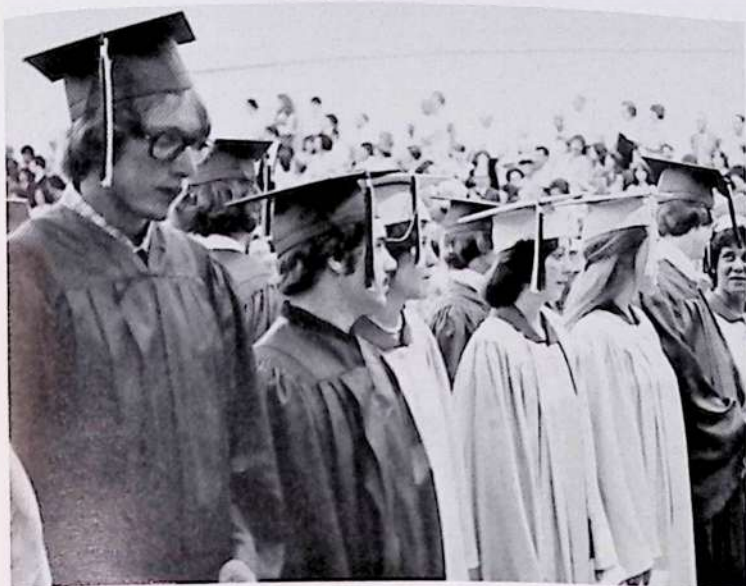

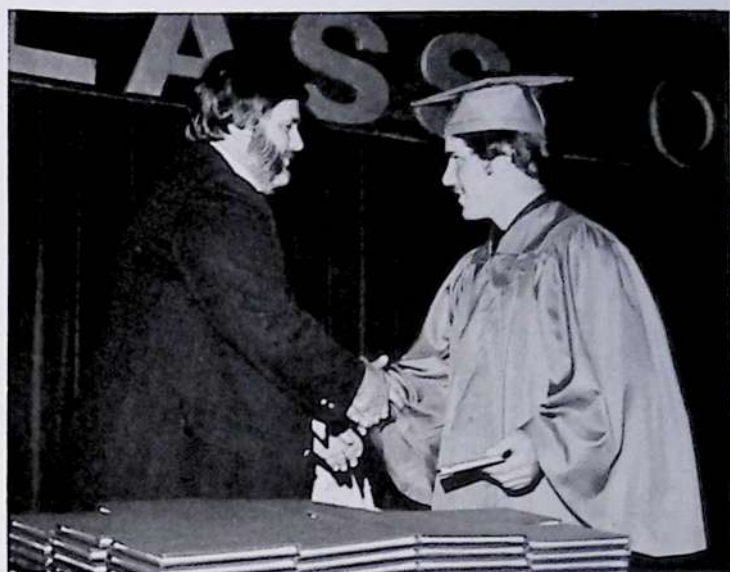

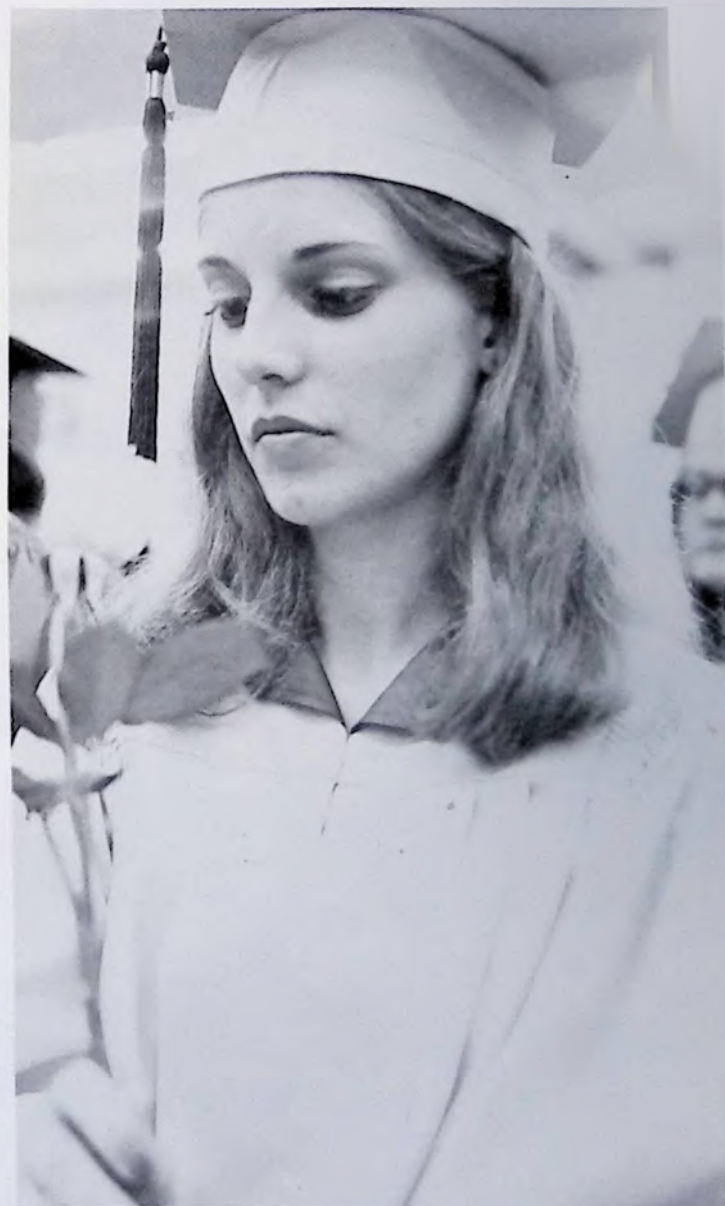
