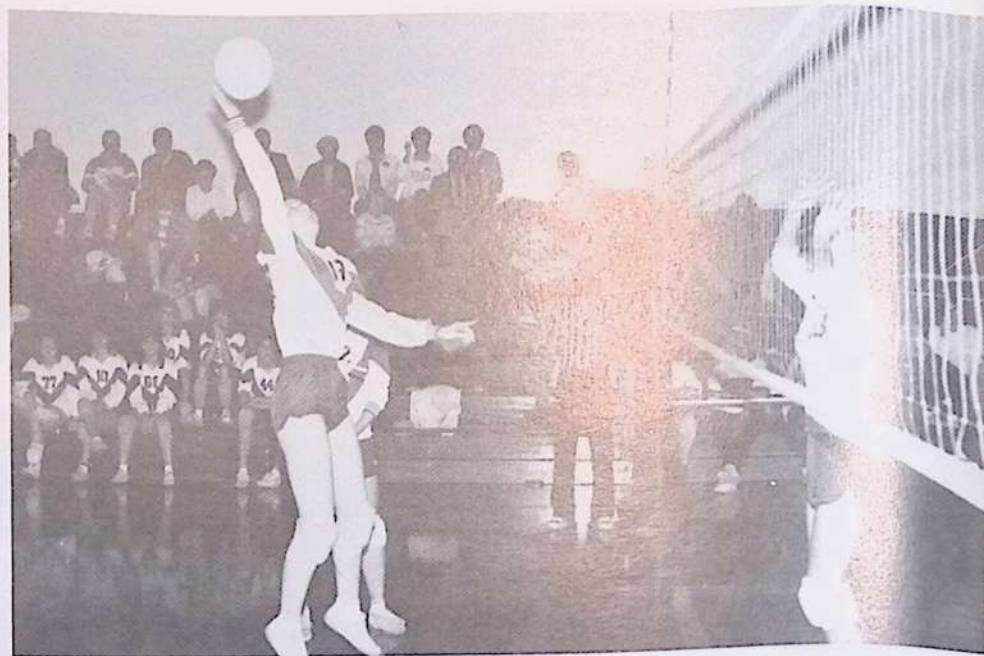

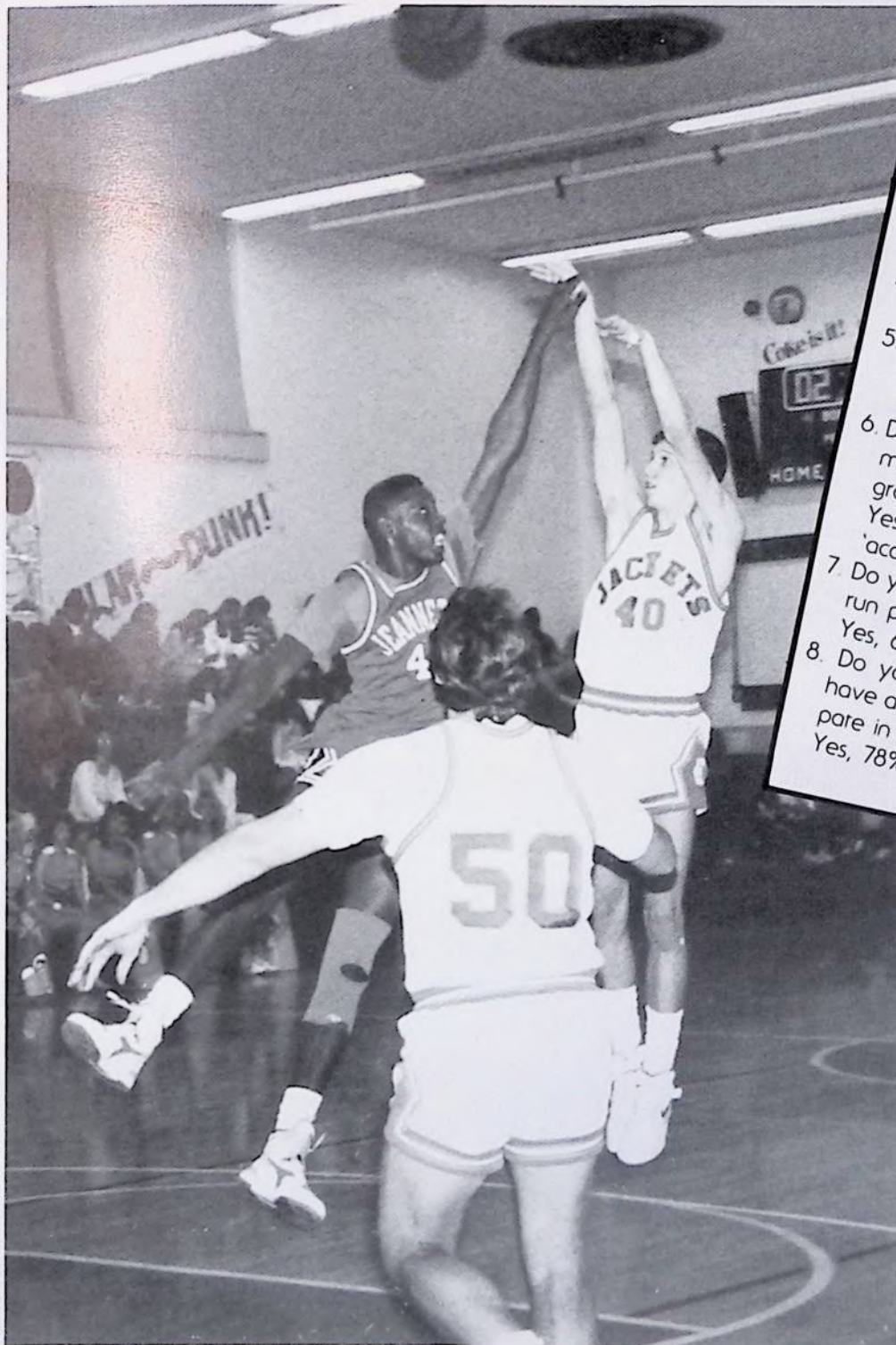

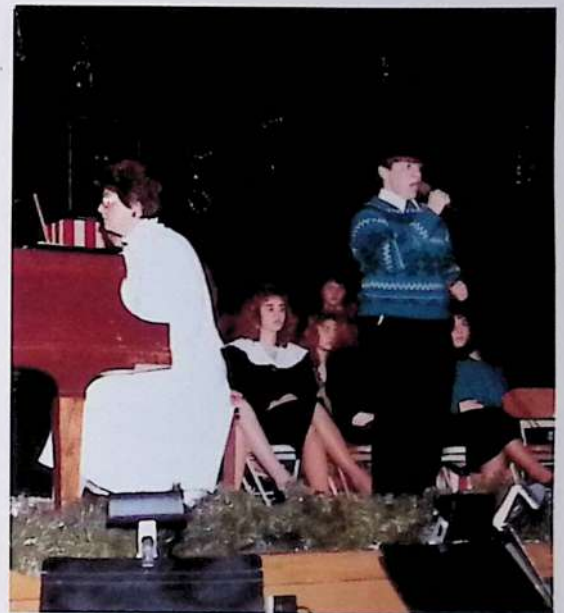

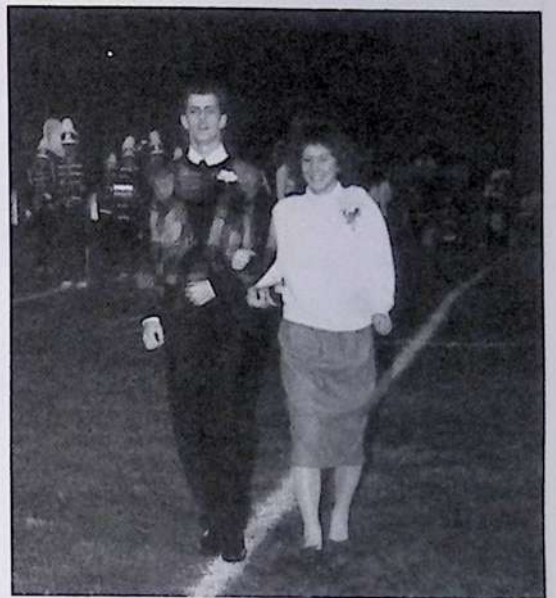

# School Board

The production of a yearbook is a year-round, time consuming task. The production of the 1989 Freeportian began in June of 1988, even before the pages of the 1988 edition were mailed.

Production begins with the selection of a theme. Once the theme is selected, the staff must decide the basic layout format for the book. The cover and divider pages must then be designed and drawn. Then it has to be decided how to carry the theme throughout the book.

The job of the Business Manager is to sell ads to help pay for the book. She must also recruit people to promote, take orders for and distribute the book.

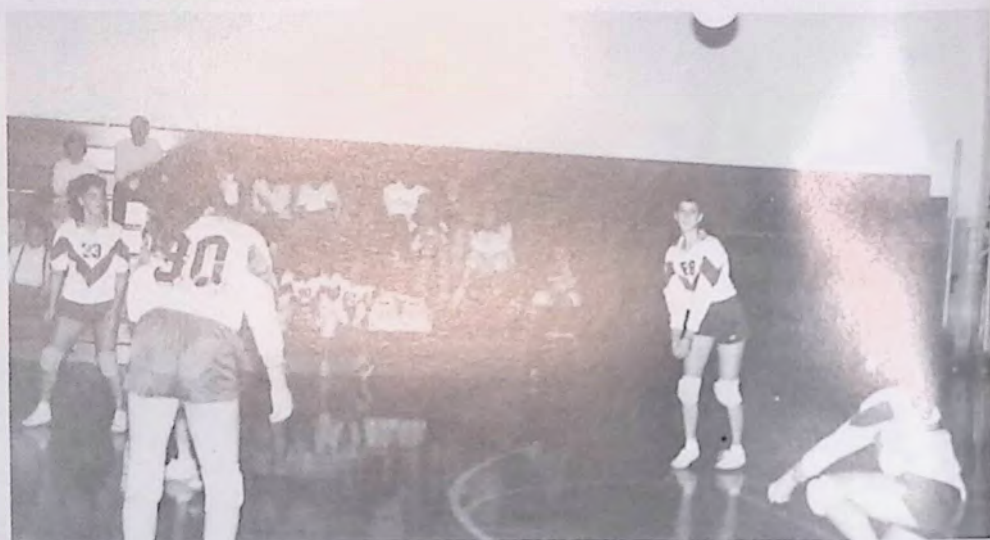

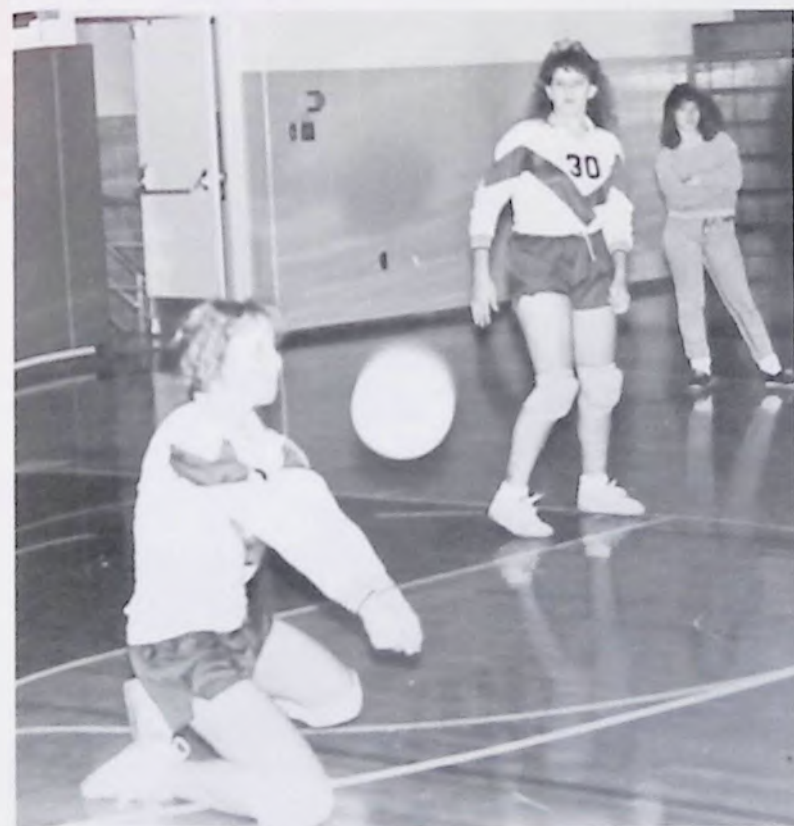
