Students Go For Gold At Science Olympiad

On March 16, 1990, Freeport Junior High participated in the Science Olympiad at Clarion University. 31 other teams participated.

In order to prepare for the event the students had to study at home and at school. This included such things as learning rocks and minerals, reading star charts and topographic maps, writing BASIC computer programs, and learning to identify leaves.

n addition to studying they had to

build the following structures: 1. A wooden bridge; 2. A paper airplane from standard 8½" x 11" paper; 3. An egg drop package to protect an egg dropped from 4 meters; 4. An insulated house for heat retention; and 5. A vehicle propelled only by the spring of a mousetrap.


The Athletic Games and Weight Training Club at the Junior High School is a club founded to promote athletic competi-














Another Dynasty Continues: Girls Reach WPIAL Finals
