#### FREEPORT AREA SENIOR HIGH

"National Blue Ribbon Award" Recognition Dinner - June 3, 1998

One of the nation's best kept secrets was divulged on May 22, 1998! Freeport Area Senior High School was named one of the best high schools in the nation by the U.S. Department of Education. Freeport is now one of only 166 schools nationwide to receive the Blue Ribbon School Award for 1997-98. Qualifications for the award were the school's strong leadership, sense of mission, quality of teaching, community involvement, policies, and commitment to students, resulting in high achievement scores, advanced curriculum, and a safe school environment. Mr. Robert Schleiden felt there was something special at the school and decided to compete for the award. He enlisted Mrs. Laurel Shimek, senior high English teacher, to edit the application compiled by faculty, support staff and administration. This is the first national honor in the school district's history and according to Dr. Tylinski -- "The Super

Bowl of Education."






Mrs. Stauffer's Child Development Class was once again a big hit with the parents in the community. Senior High Students ran a preschool class for the children.
























#### Class of '98 Graduation


#### Basketball




