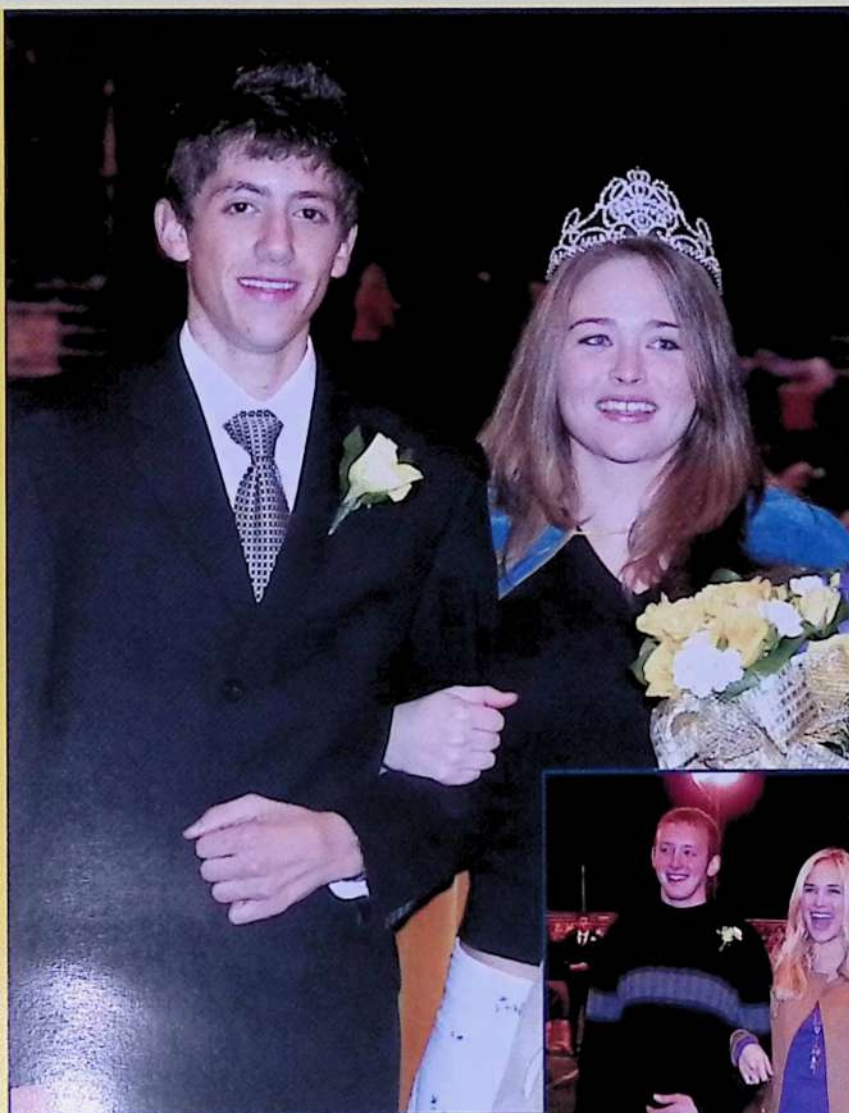

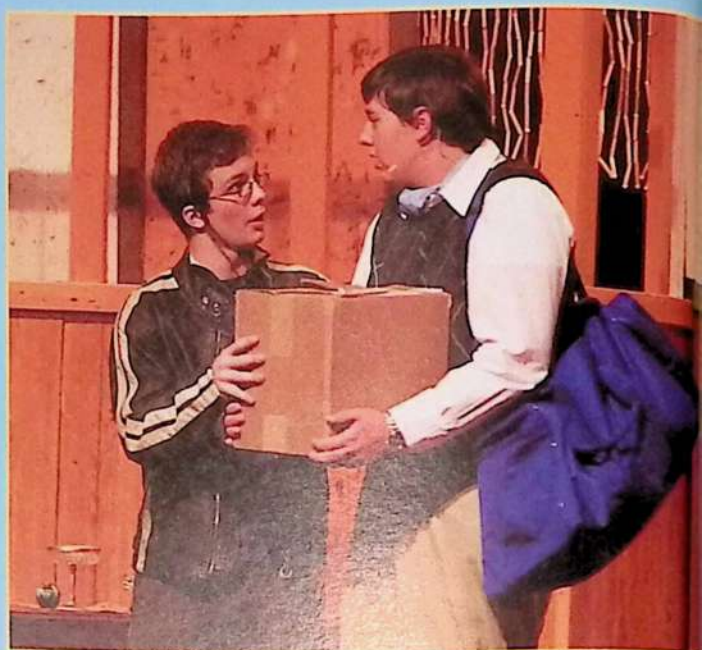

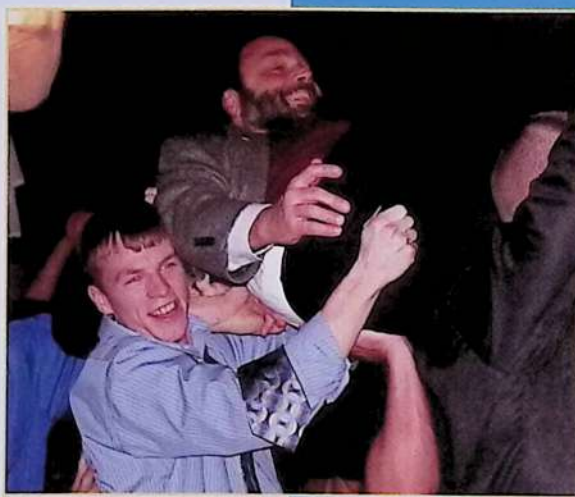

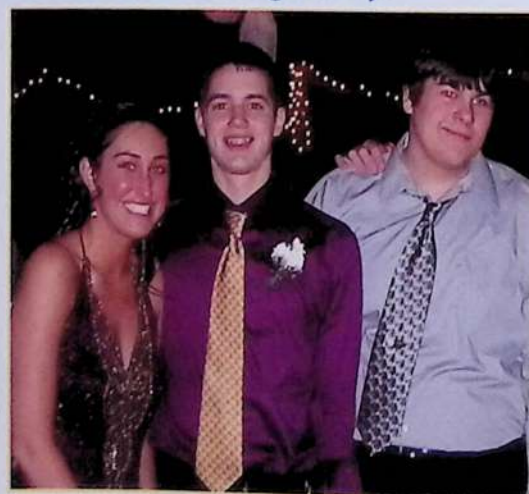

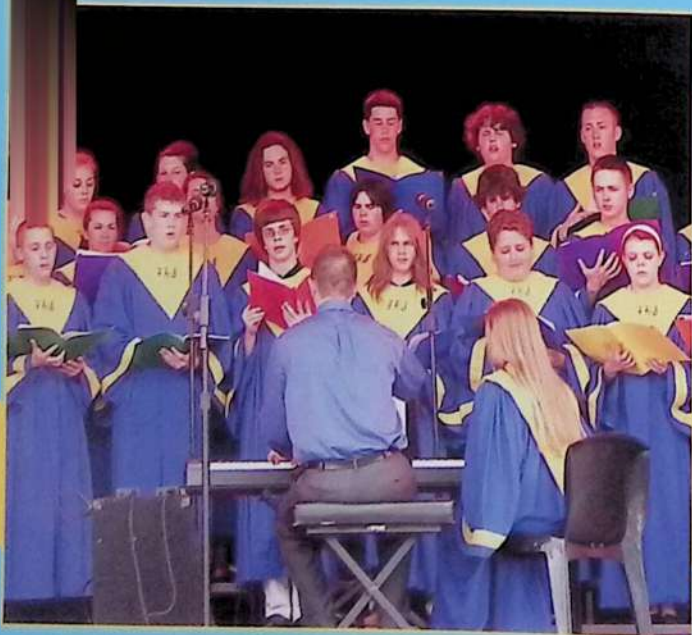

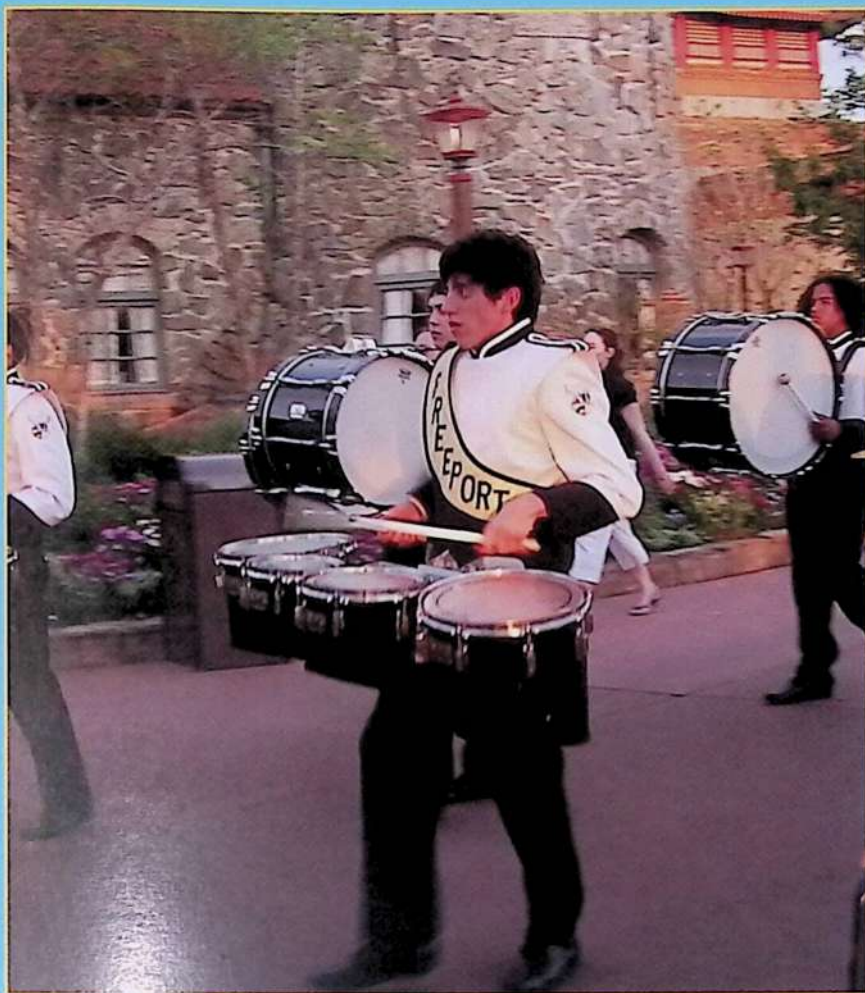

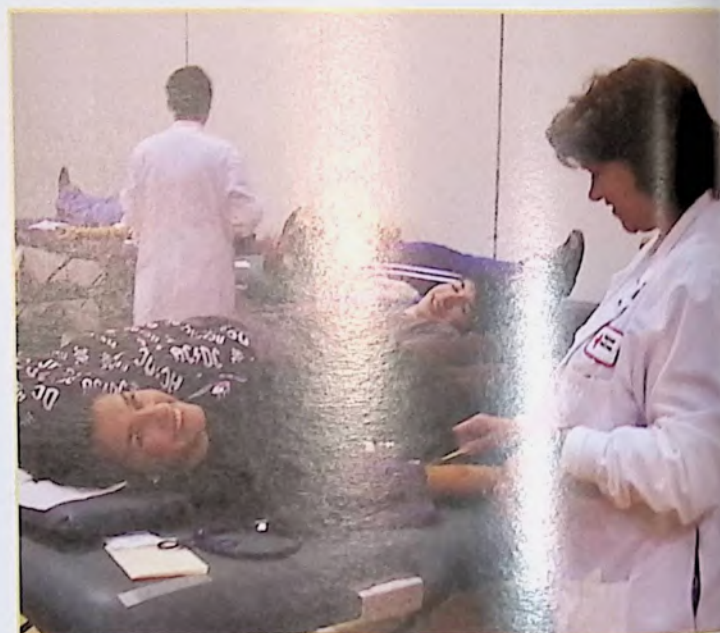

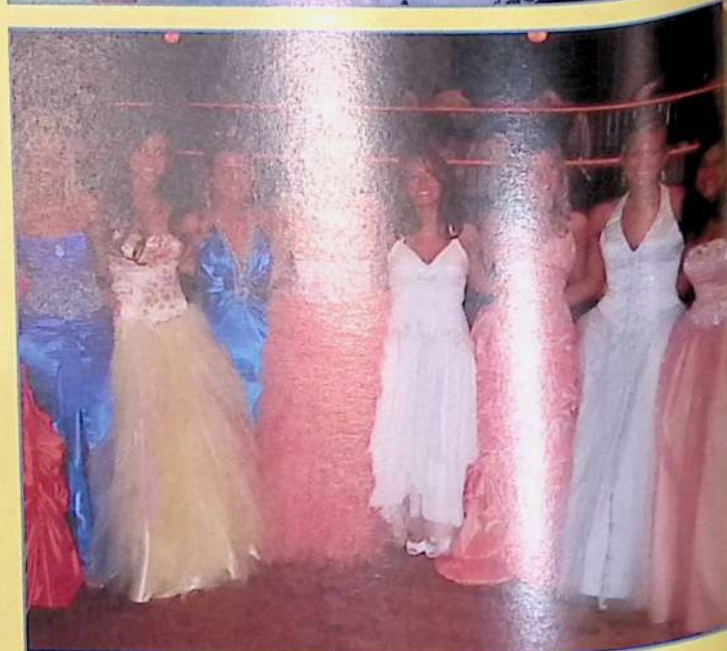

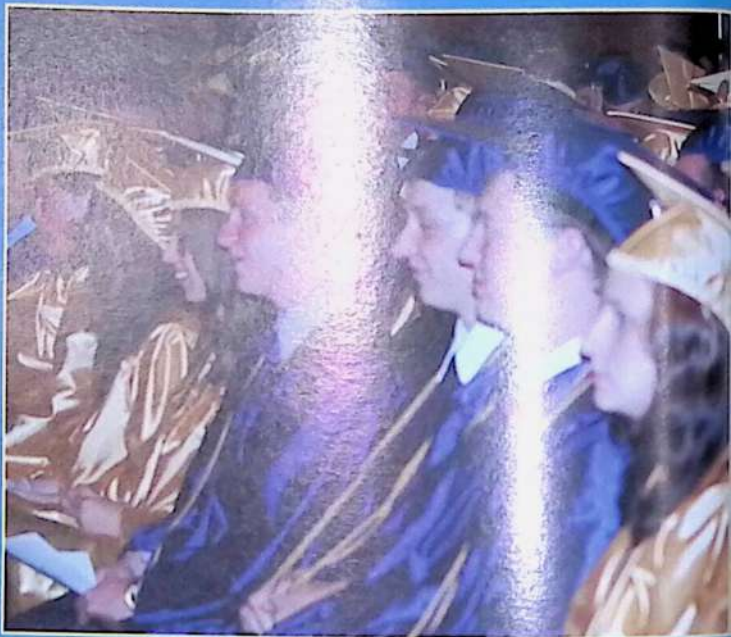
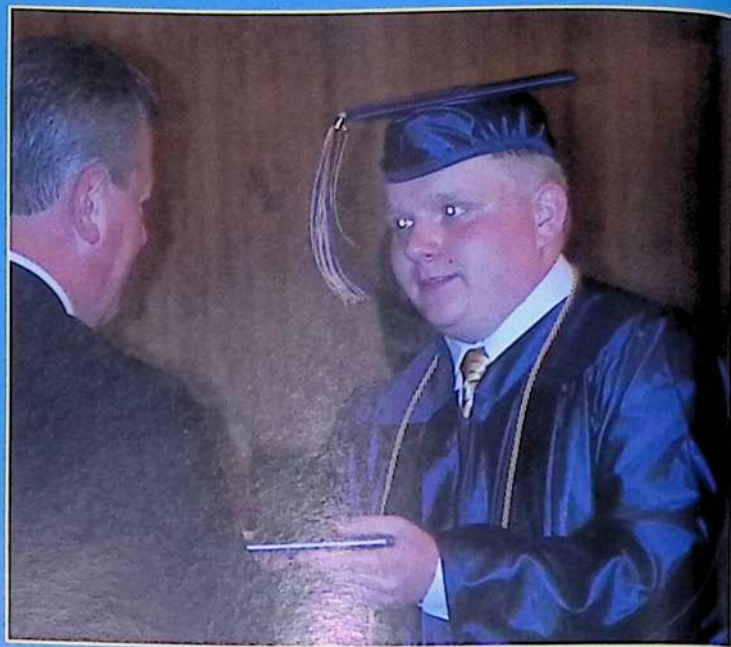
# Graduation

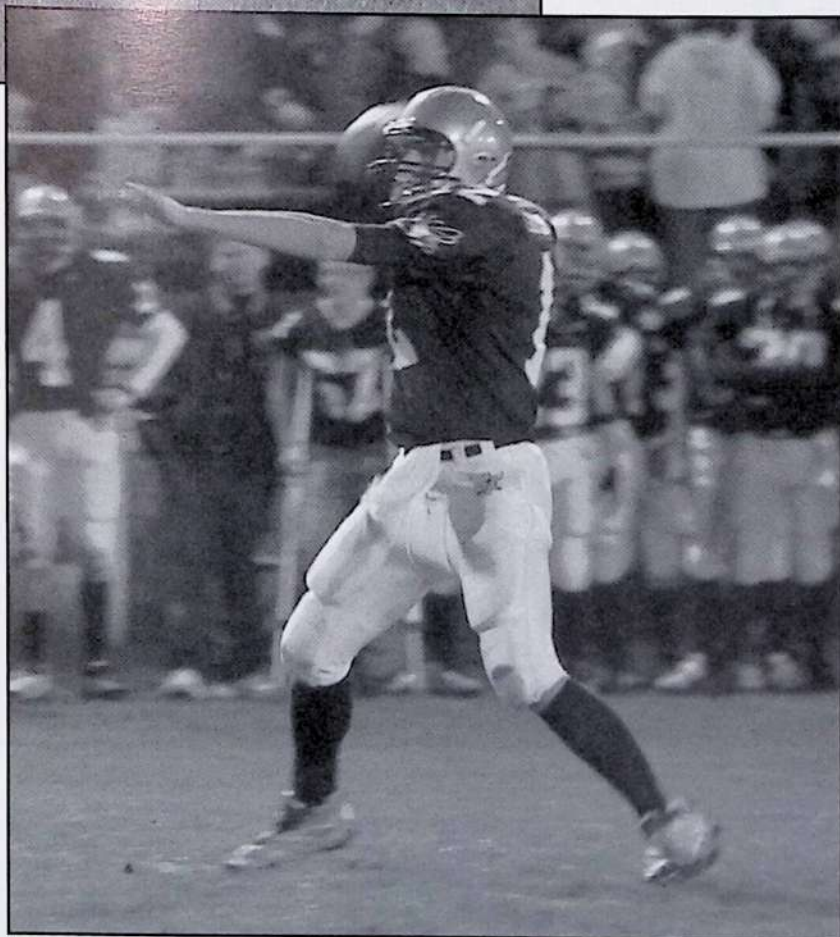
# VARSITY FOOTBALL

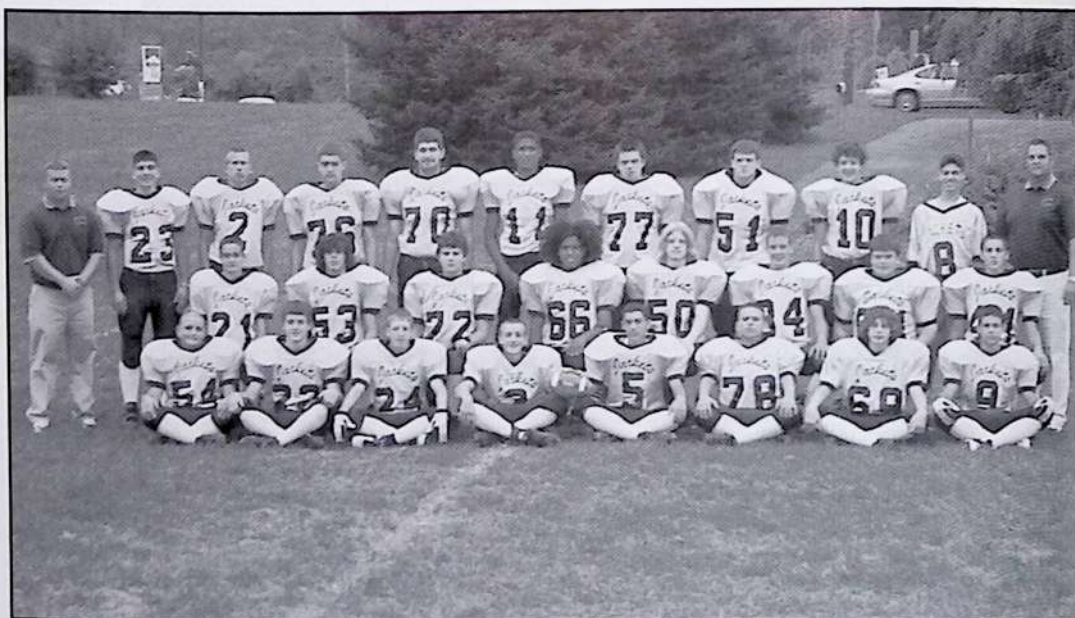

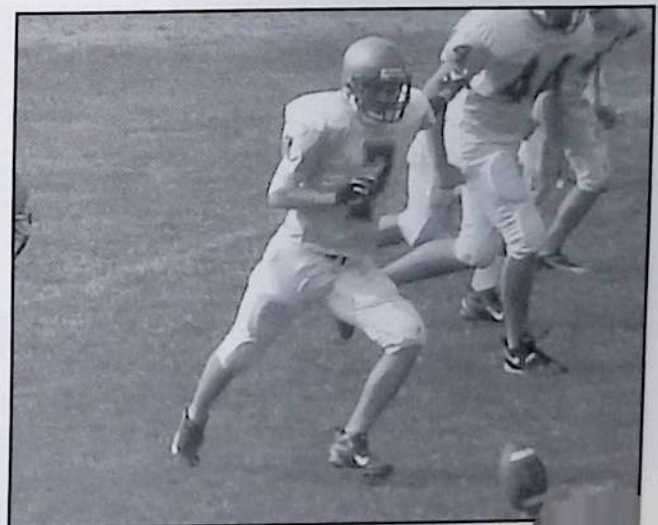
# JV/9TH GRADE FOOTBALL

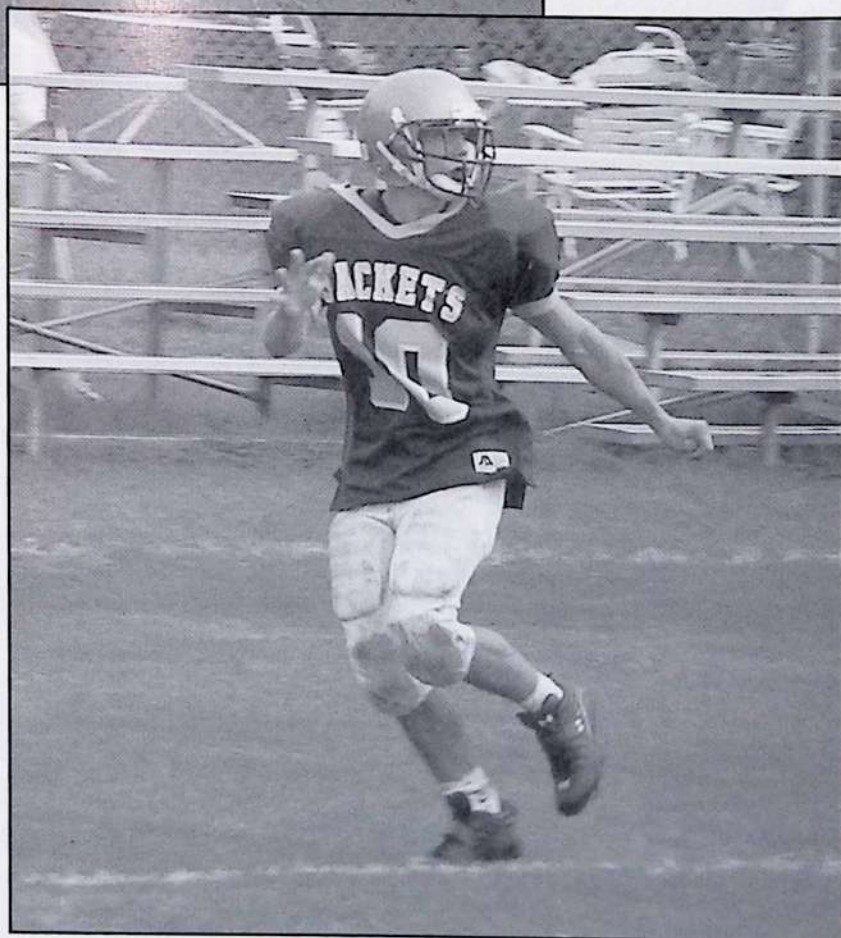

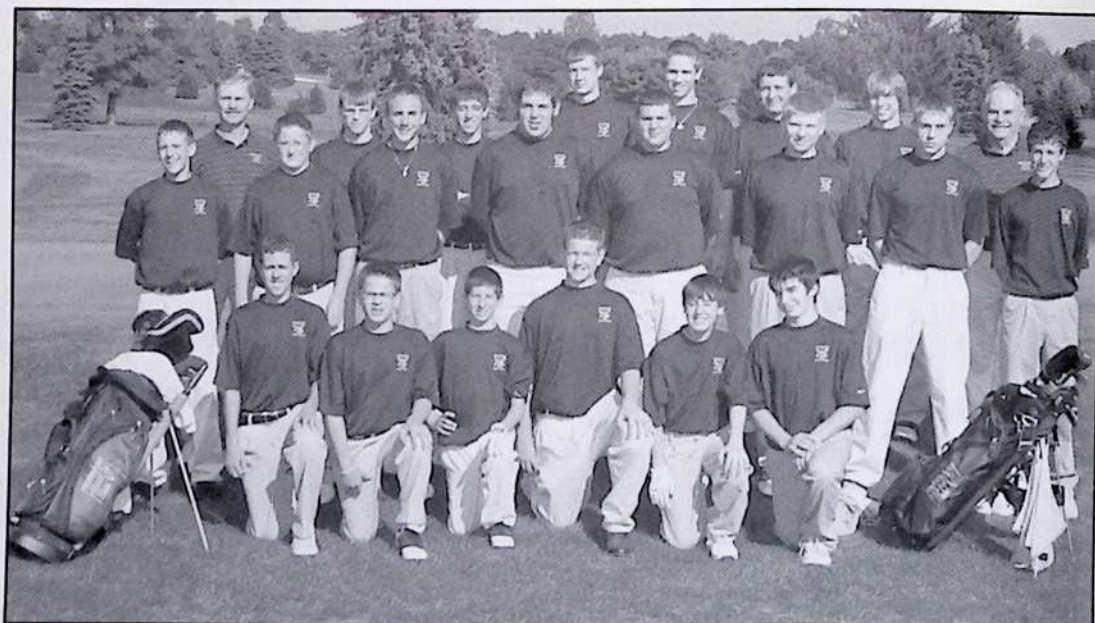

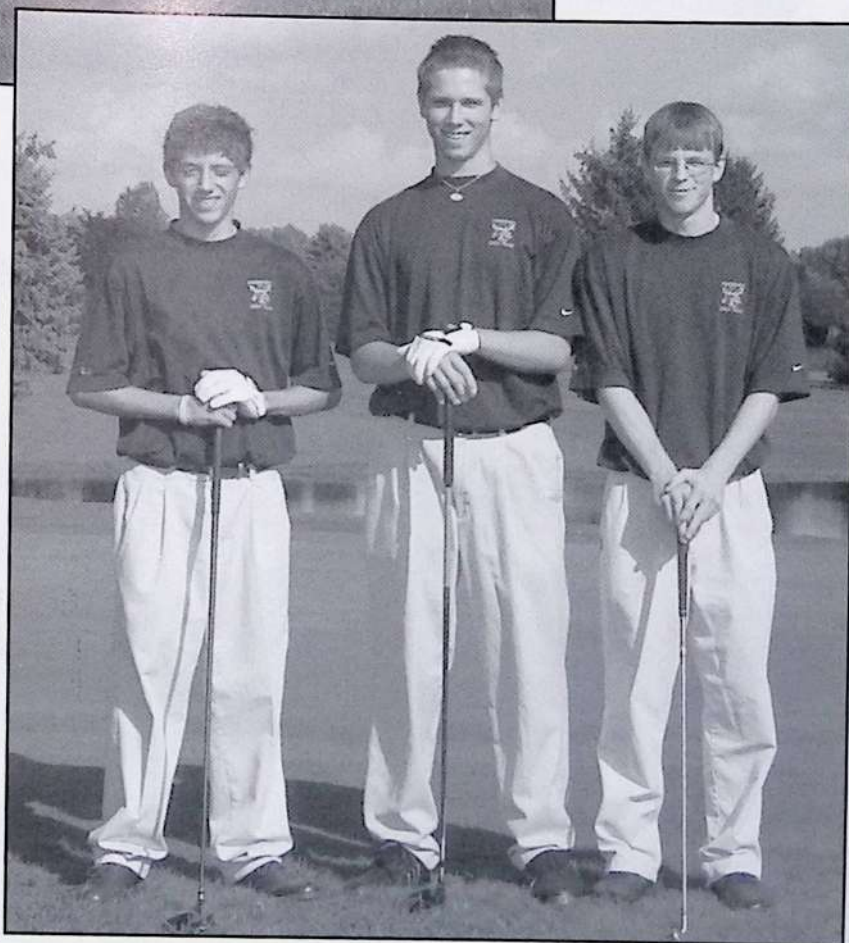


# JV/VARSITY GOLF

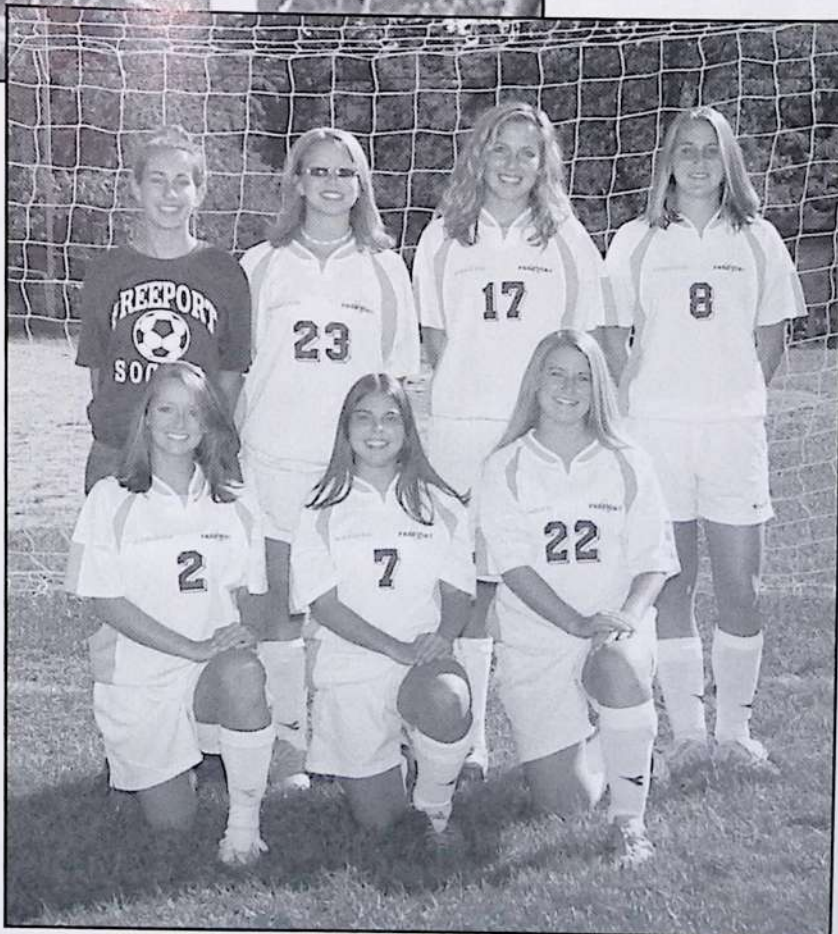

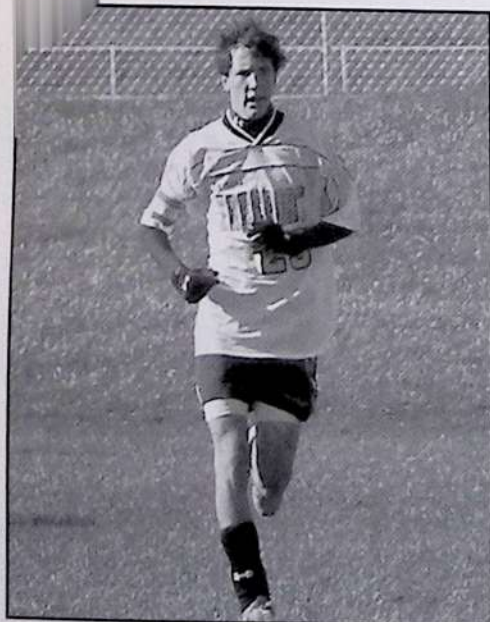

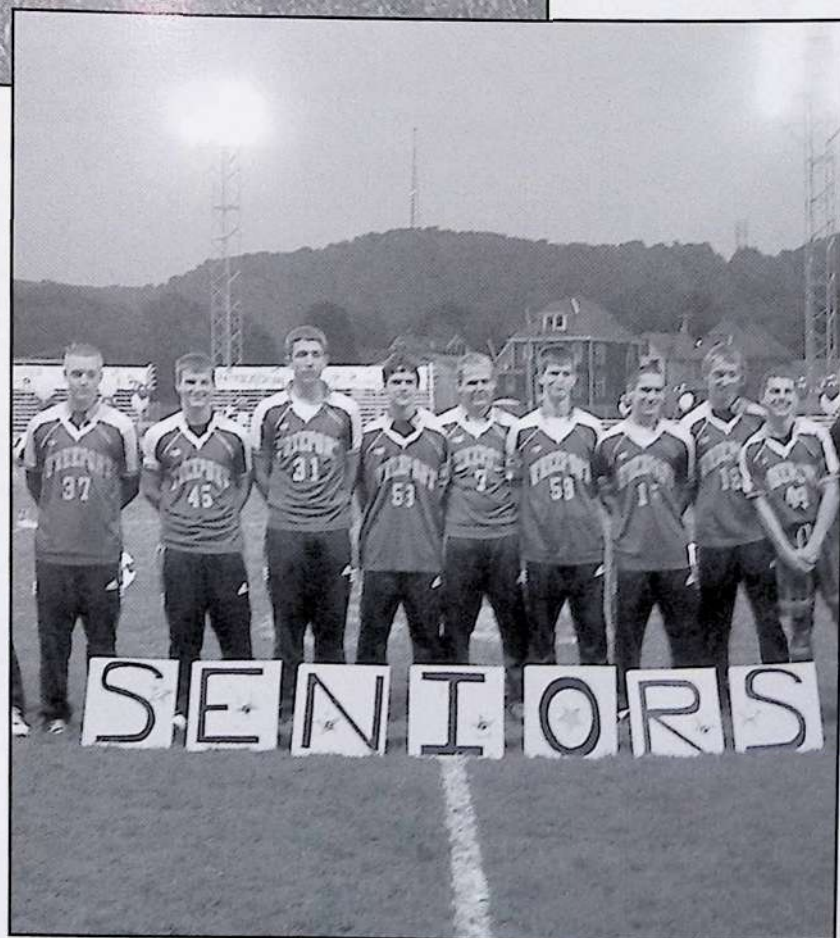


# BOYS SOCCER

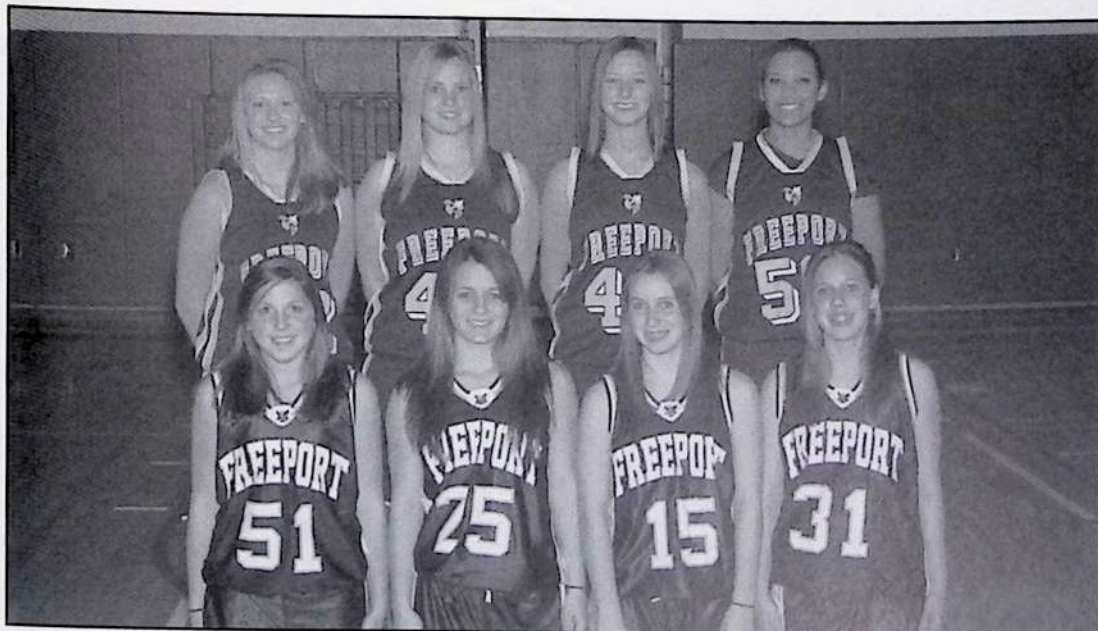




# GIRLS VARSITY/JV BASKETBALL

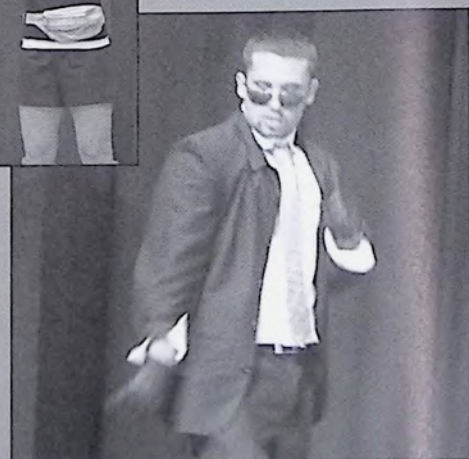

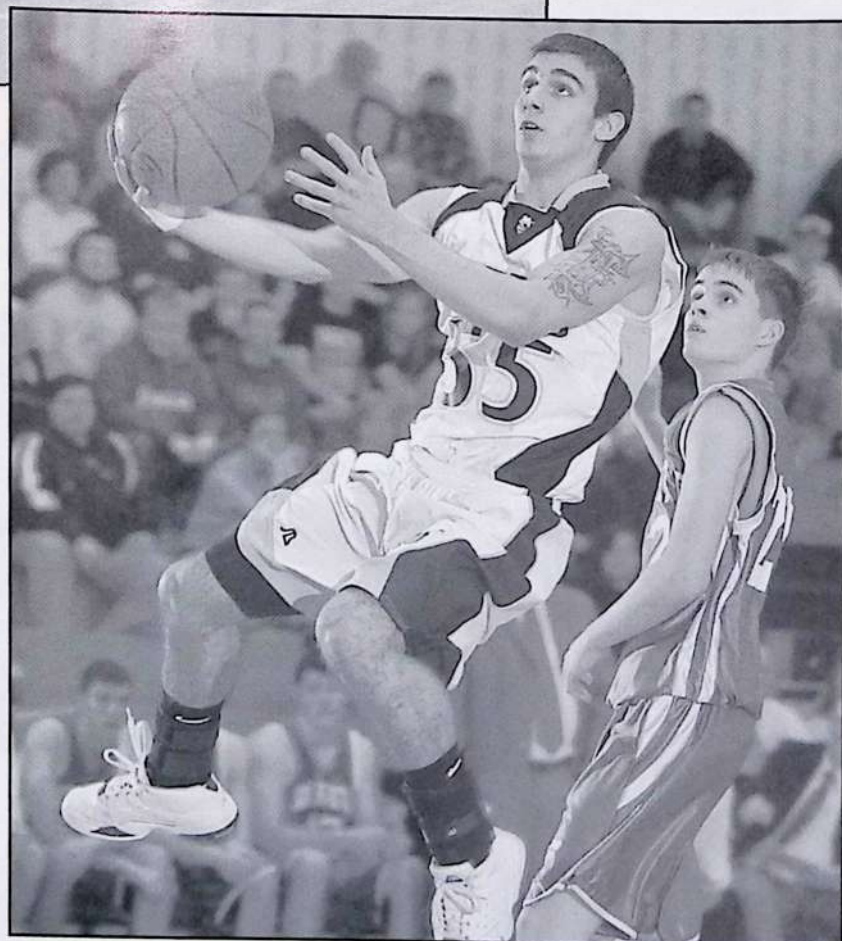

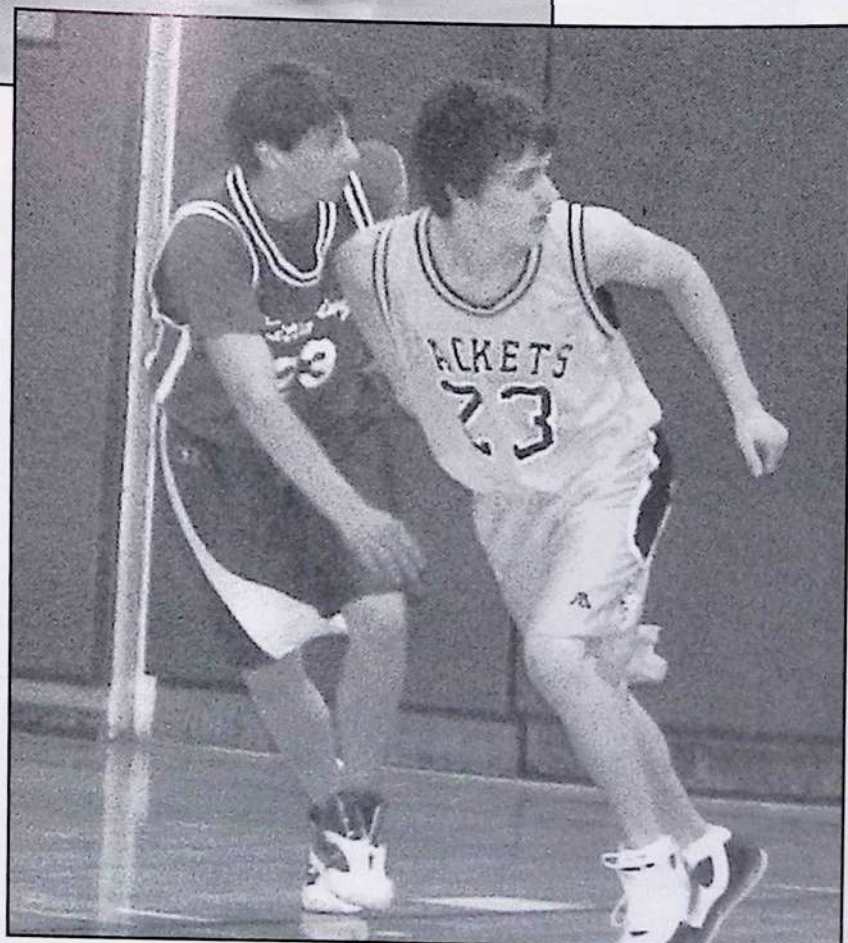


# JV/9TH BOYS BASKETBALL

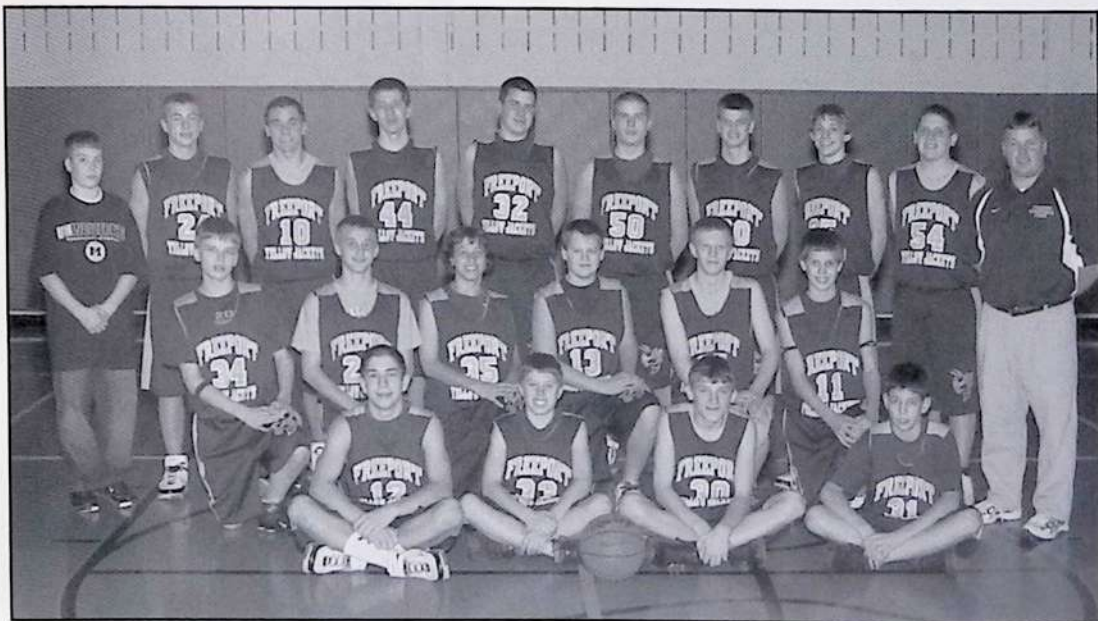

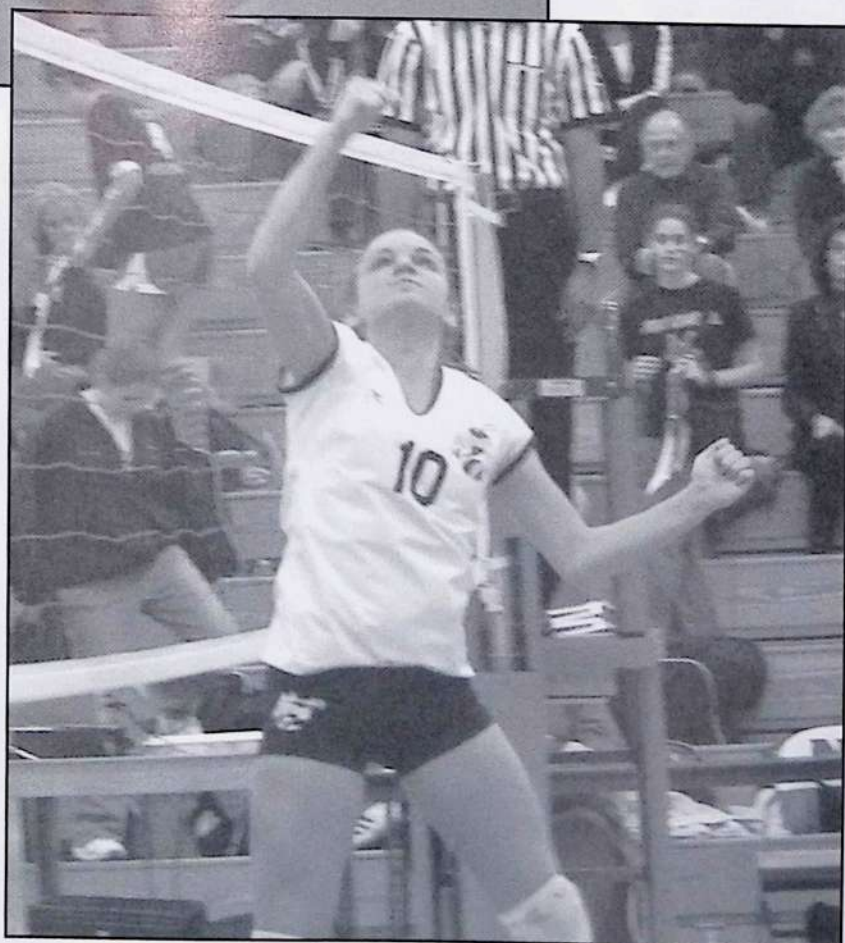

# BOYS TRACK

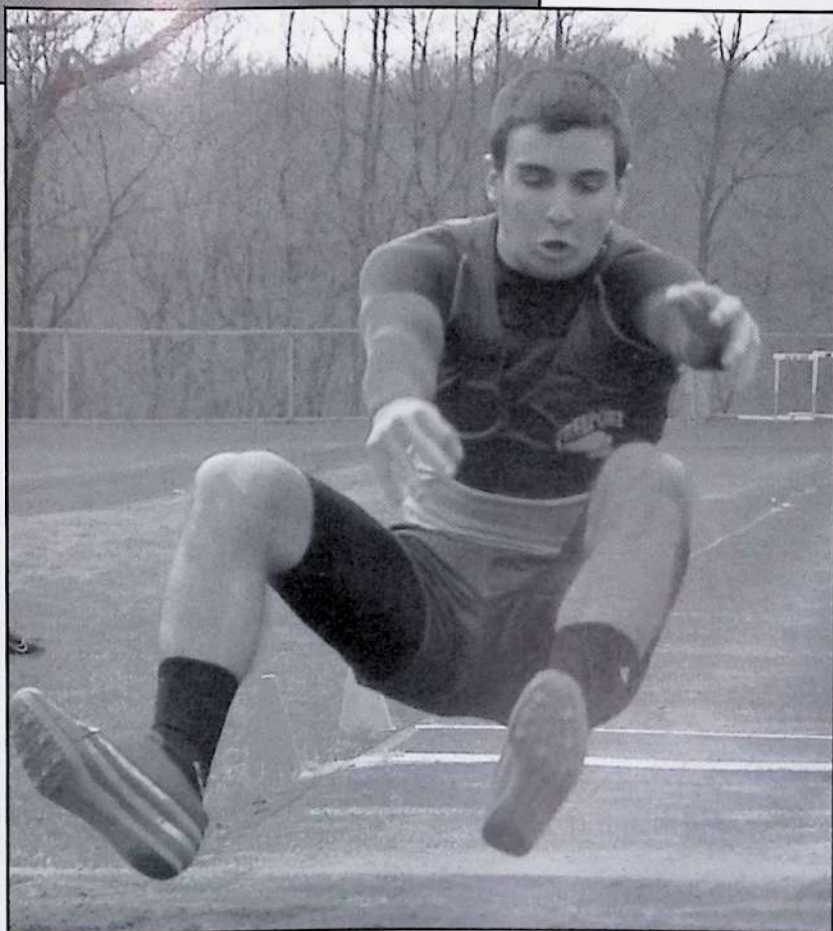
