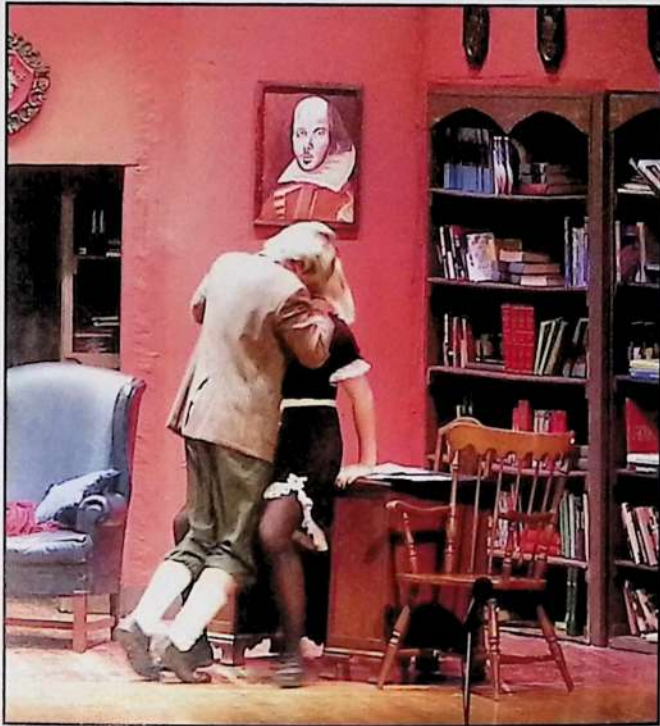

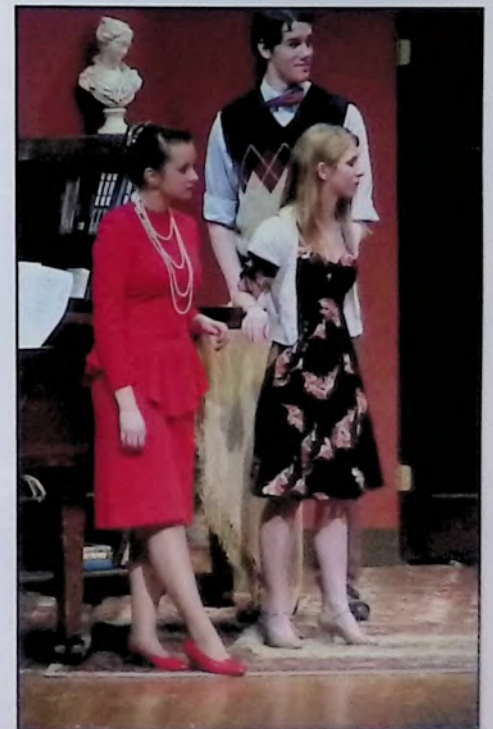

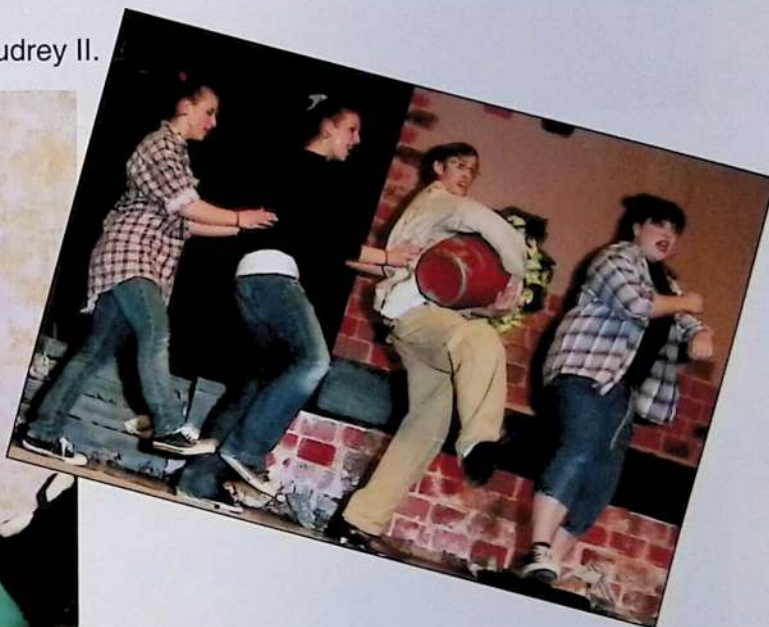

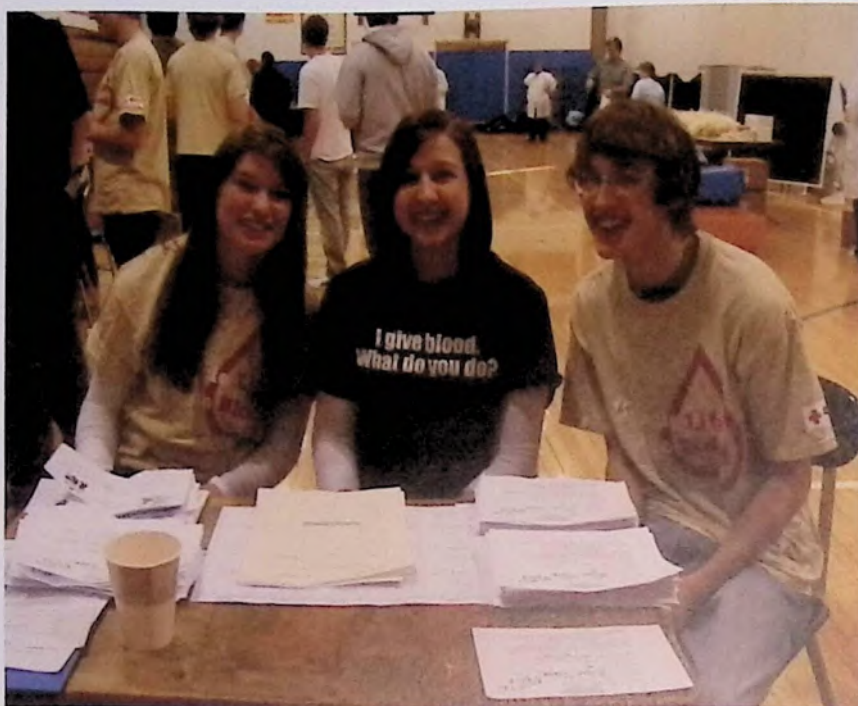
## Little Shop of Horrors

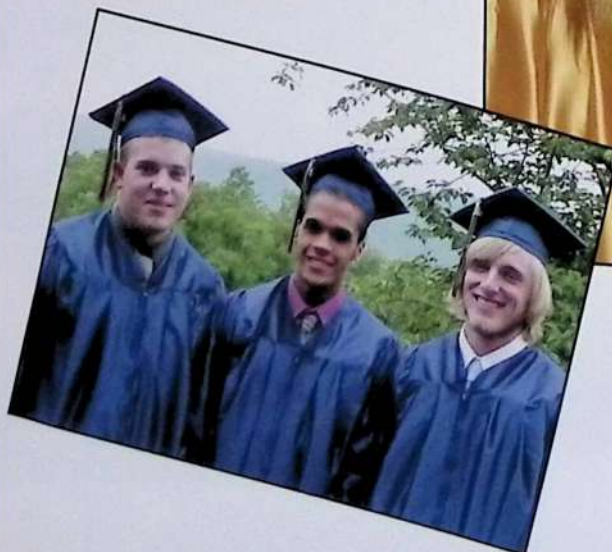

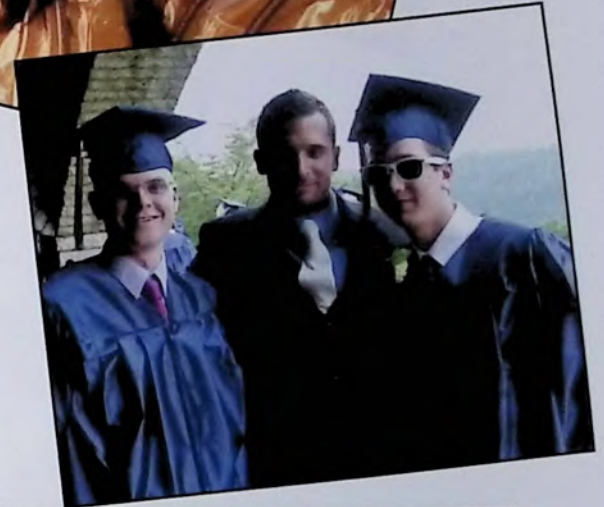

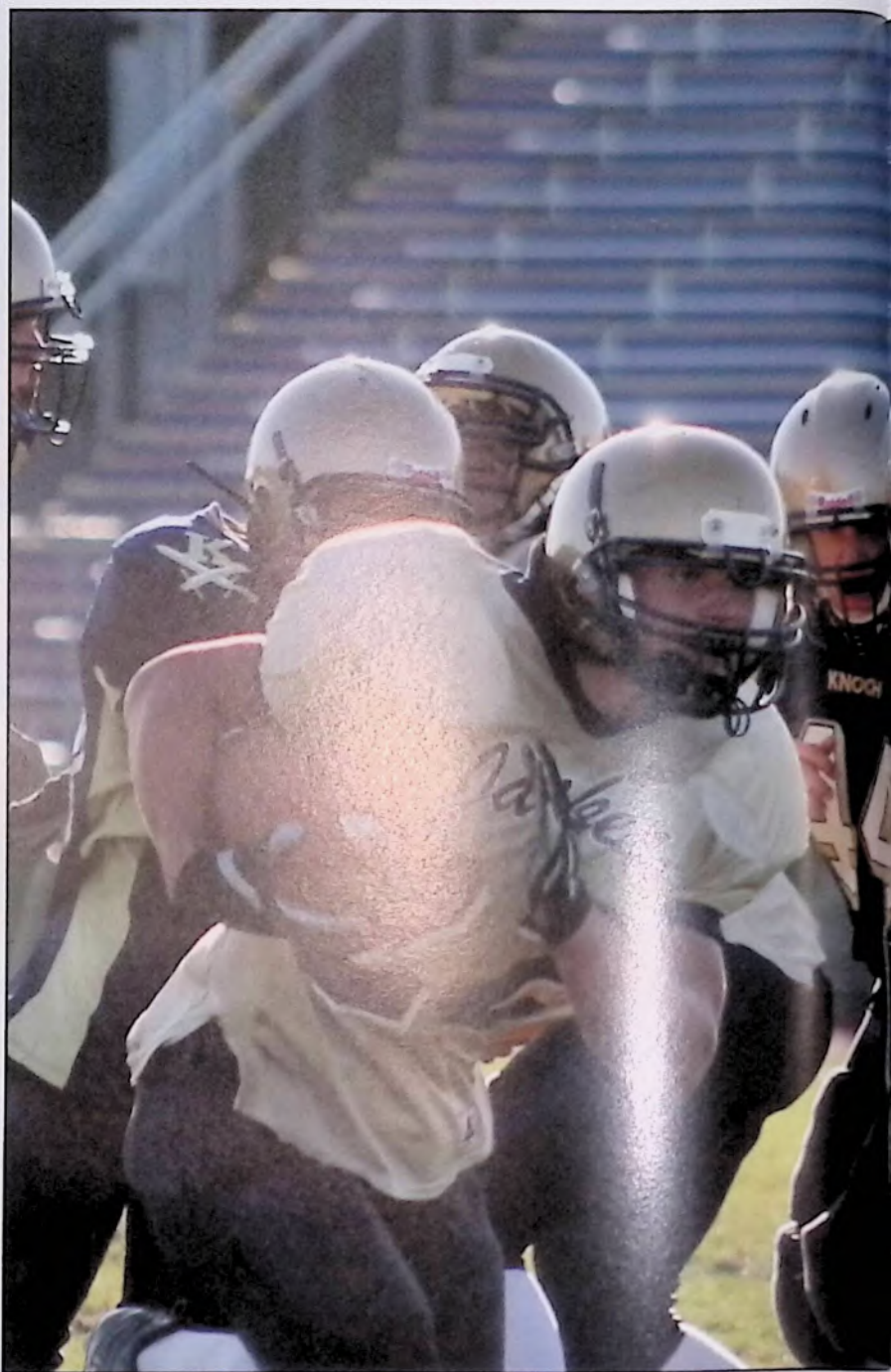


Above: Quarterback, Sean Carson, talks to his coach after a tough play.

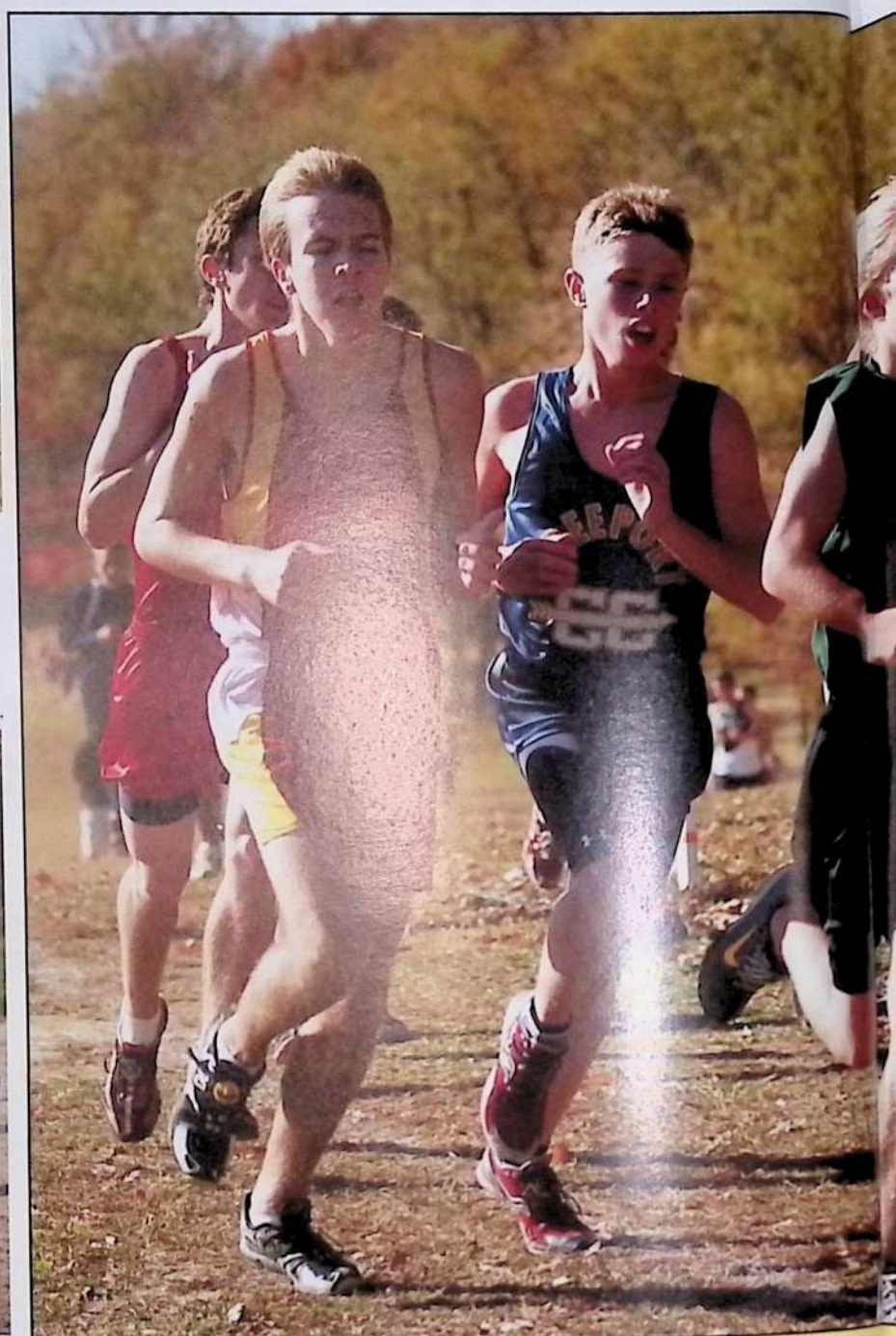

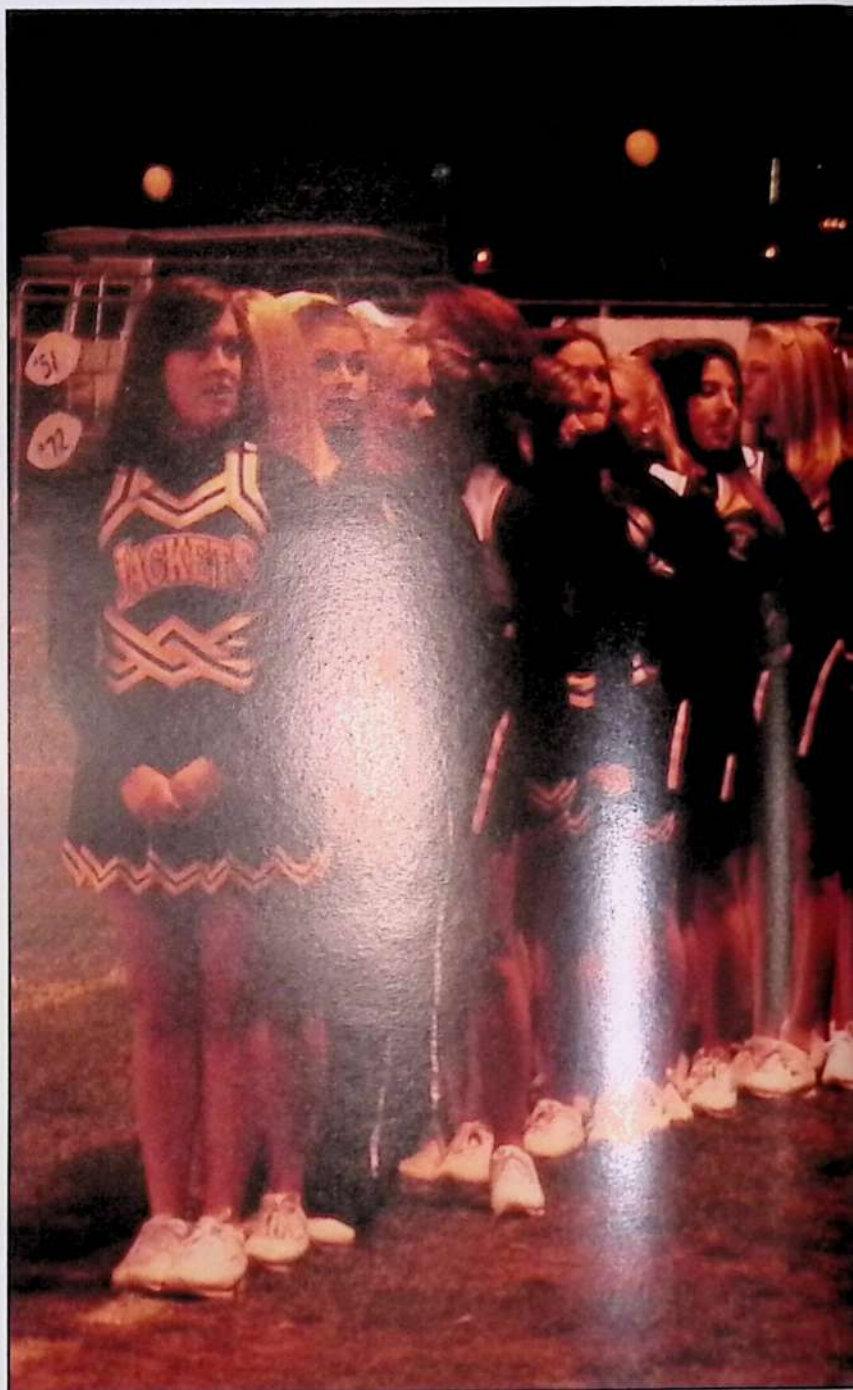

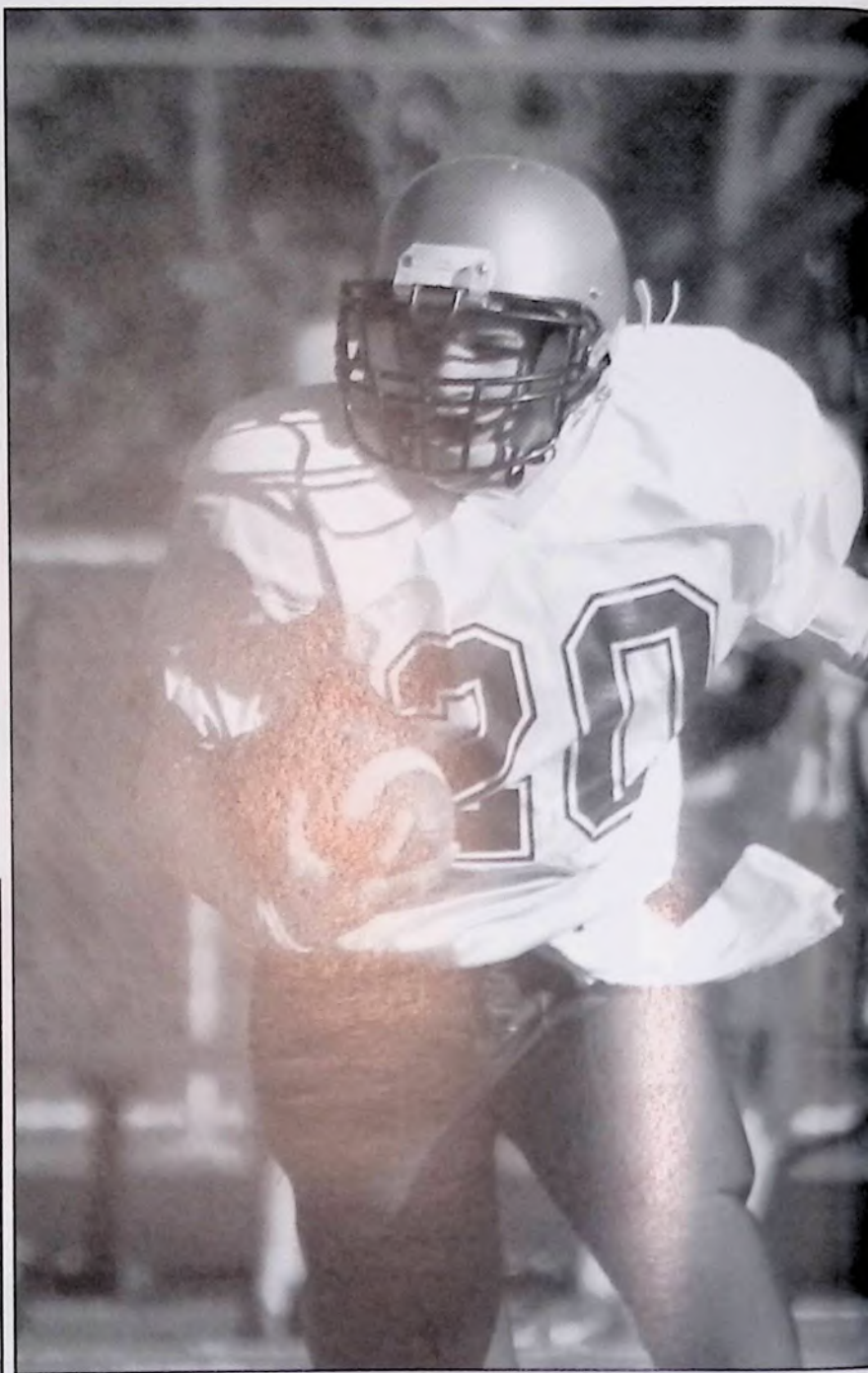

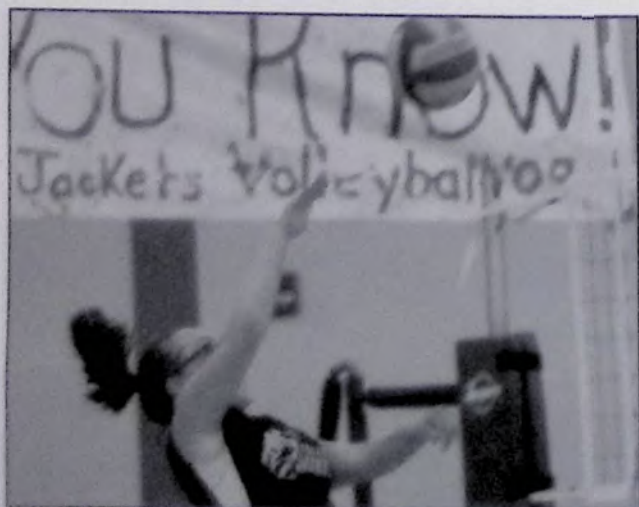
