





PEOPLE ARE MANY THINGS



The class play illustrates many traits of the people of Kiski: creativity, ingenuity, and willingness to work.













In addition to the motto, the seniors chose green and white as their colors, and the white rose as the class flower.









Highlights of the year's activities included the designing of original Christmas cards and a guest speaker, Mr. Matthews of the Pittsburgh Art Institute.






STUDENT COUNCIL, AUDIO-VISUAL CLUB
