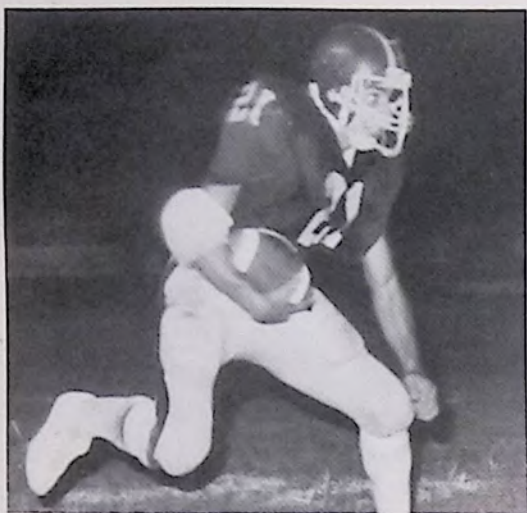
There was great team effort from all the players. There just wasn't one or two players that were outstanding. The whole A-R Viking team was terrific!

Congratulations guys and coaches. "We're proud of what you've done this season." Thanks for the memories, Vikes!

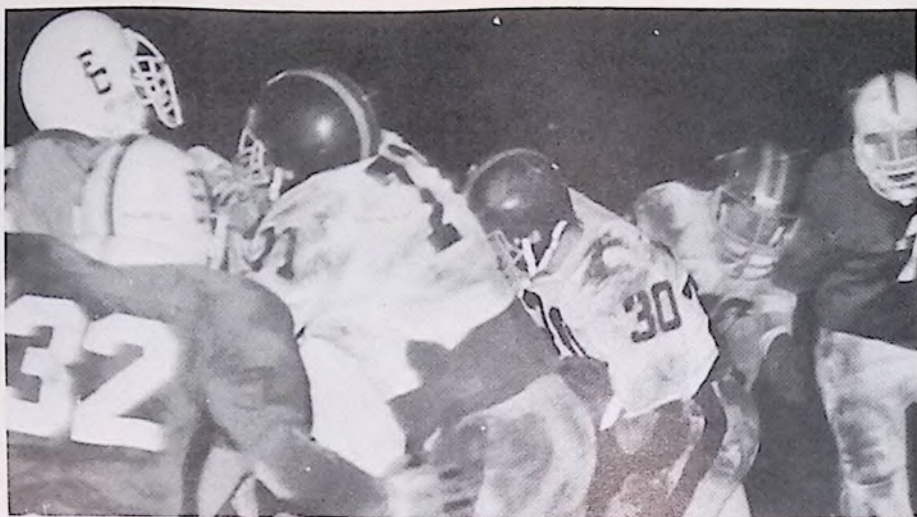
