There was great team effort from all the players. There just wasn't one or two players that were outstanding. The whole A-R Viking team was terrific!



On December 2 and 3, 1984, the Mixed Ensemble and the A-R students once again presented the third annual Madrigal Dinner.



The team went under reconstruction which has shown in its success by the team's winning record. The team had rough practices, but they will agree that all the sweat has paid off. Nice job guys!


































