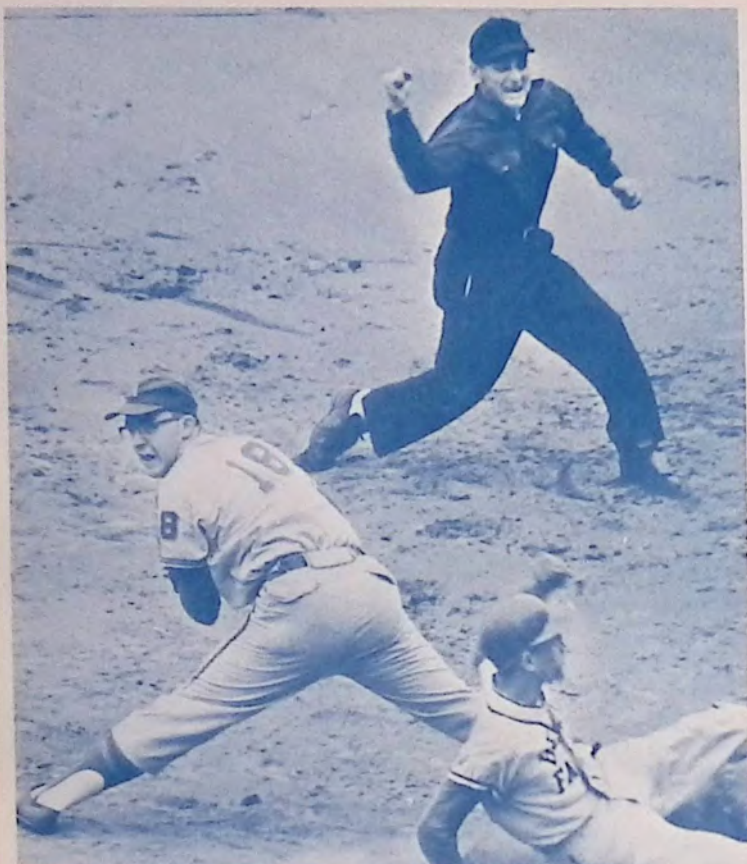


There're two!
