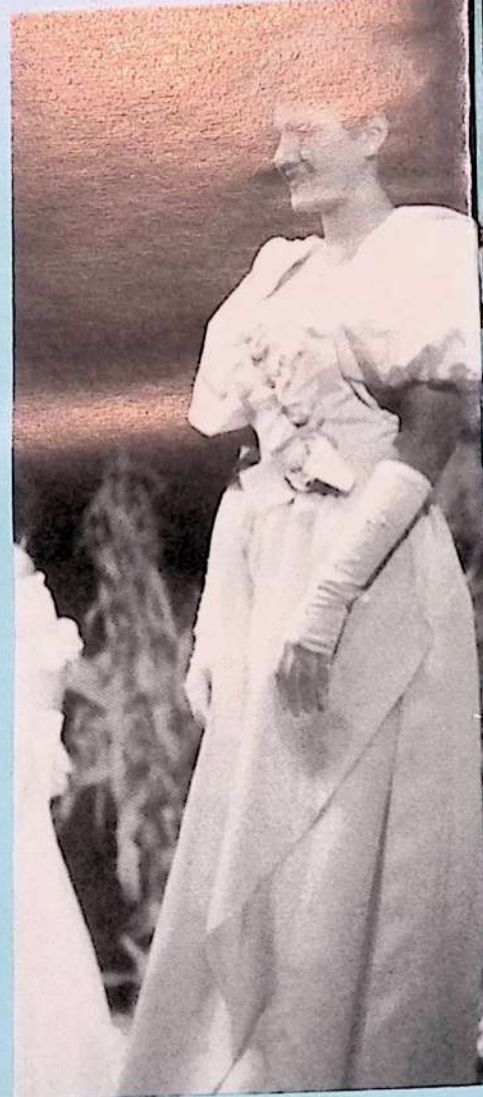

# Burrell . . . On Stage



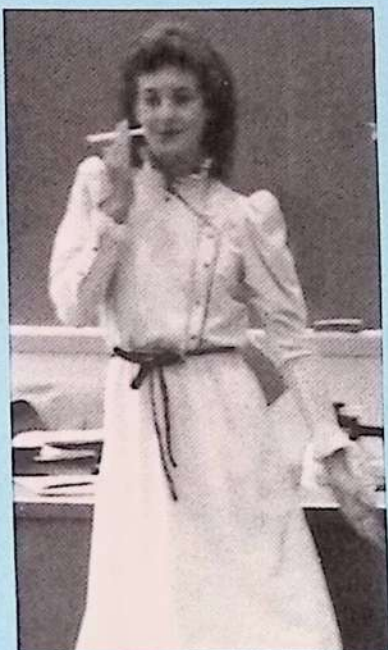


"All the world's a stage
