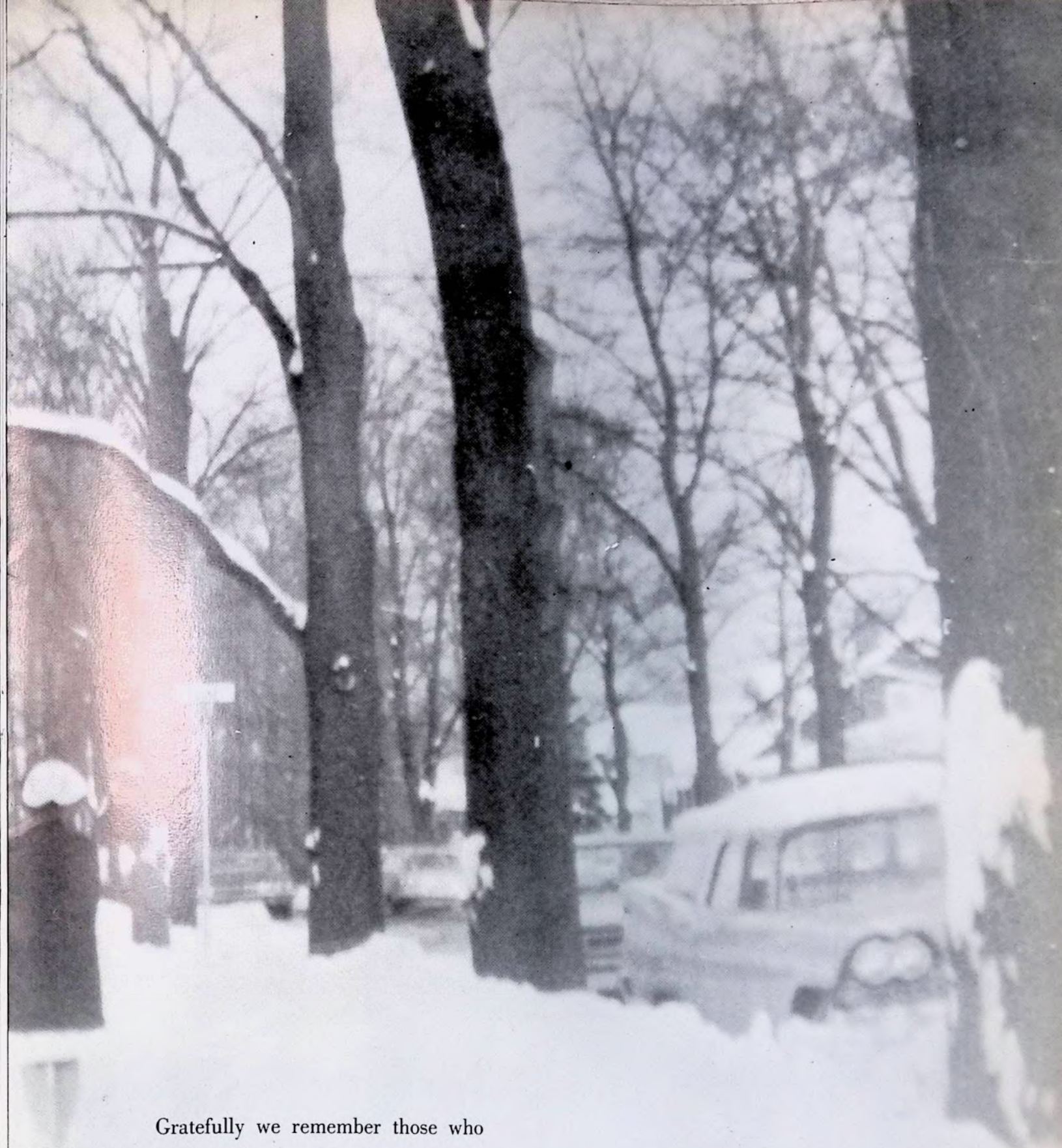
Foreword
