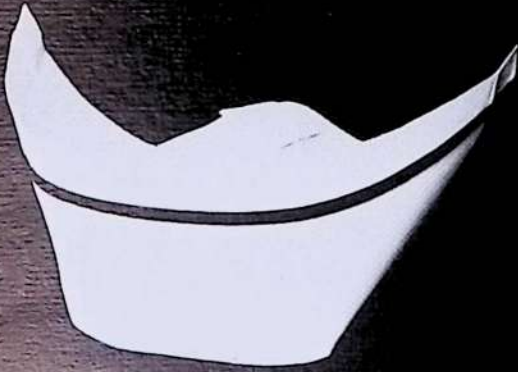

I am a student nurse.



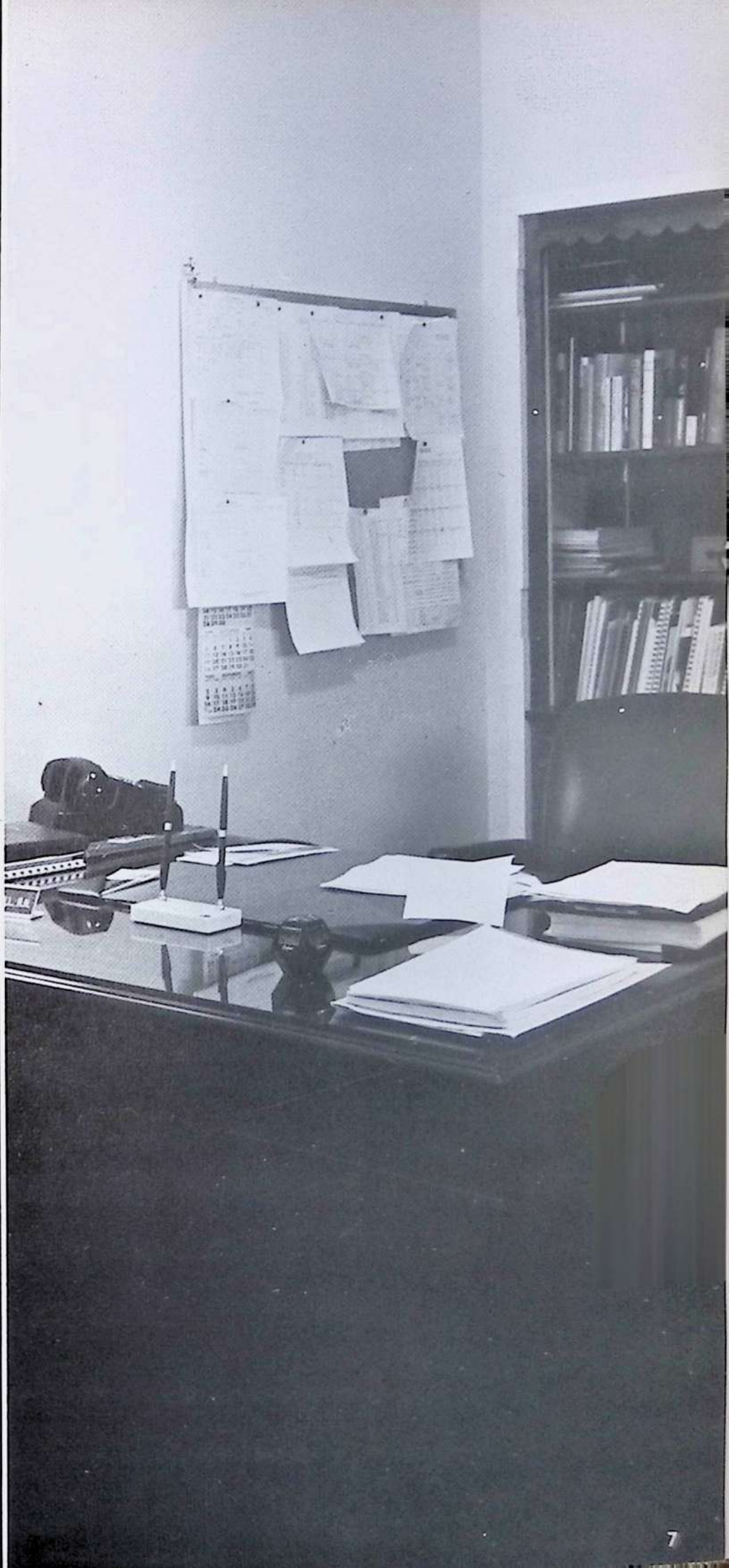
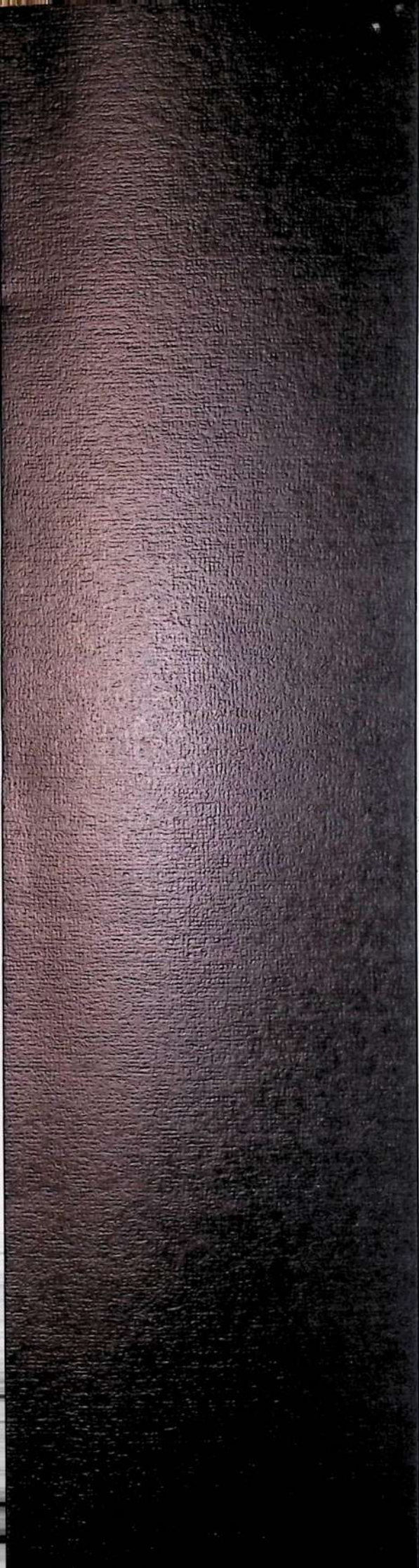
