MEMORIES OF EDFRA HIGH

MEMORIES

We, the class of 1969, the last graduating class of East Deer Frazer High School, wish to take this opportunity to recognize the

members and the accomplishments of the previous graduating classes.

Take for example the class of 1946 under the direction of Mr. Albert Rometo. Alfred Iuretig was elected class president. Fred Iuretig, Andy Dorich, John Andrejcik, and James Fenoglietto were named to the Lion's All-Star football team. The popular Gloria Mazzoni was crowned May queen.

In 1947 the football team was declared 1946 Class B champs and the Antler staff was awarded a National Scholastic Press associ-

ation award. Arka Mae Bertolino was crowned senior queen.

The dawning of the 1948 coronation was heralded by trumpeteers Andrew Kengor and Joseph Lehosky. Chosen by her classmates as senior queen, Betty Wasil was crowned in a whirl of white taffeta and satin. Crowned by Miss Etta Singleton, former high school principal, Betty reigned as queen of the May.

In 1949 and after 36 years of service to the community Mr. James E. Clark, the supervising principal of the school decided to retire. The school had experienced its first merger and the official title read East Deer-Frazer Union School District. Miss Joan

Errico was crowned senior queen.

Nineteen years ago, in 1950, Mr. Albert R. Rometo was selected as our new supervising principal. The 1950 queen was Audrey Sprowls and her Chief Lady-In-Waiting was Gladys Galli. On June 5, 1950, the East Deer-Frazer Union School board was asked to accept a resignation submitted by Miss Etta Singleton, high school principal. It was unanimously approved with the deepest and

most sincere regrets of the school board.

During the year 1951, three monumental incidents occurred at East Deer-Frazer. One, another noteworthy class was graduated; two, Mr. Andrew Petor was appointed to be the new high school principal; and three, the majority of the 1969 graduating class was born. Miss Delores Schiberl was crowned the senior May queen for 1951. The remainder of the court consisted of Clara Hirtz, Betty Bluis, Patricia Maslowski, Betty Vrana, Dorothy Atkinson, Audrey Modey, Betty Hunchar, Jean Fenoglietto, and lady-inwaiting Dorothy Harris. The coronation was under the direction of Miss Ann Sohoski.

January 19th, 1952, at a high school journalism session presented at the University of Pittsburgh, both the Antler and the school newspaper walked away with top honors in their own respective fields. Senior Georgia Ann Woolslayer was crowned queen and senior H. Lawrence Harmon was crowned the first East Deer king in the glitter of May. Miss Carol Carney and Mr. Jack Bracco

served as flower girl and crown bearer.

Christmas assemblies, treasure island projects, Sadie Hawkins dances, and Latin projects dominated the scenes of action in that wonderful year 1953. Mrs. Ann Pietrusinski was the director of the coronation in which Robert Pacek and Beverly Edgar were the reigning couple. Serving as prince and princess were Lois McCaskey and Albert Doutt. Dances were performed to the music of "April in Paris" and "Flashing Pearls."

By dedicating their yearbook to their fathers, the class of '54 proved just how sentimental a group they were. Highlights of their coronation were the "Hawaiian Dance" and the "Fancy Pants" dance. The zenith of the evening was reached when Elenor Ruman

and Anthony Pelligrino were crowned senior queen and king.

In 1955, Rosemary Lisko and Robert Bellinotti were the leaders of the senior court. Mrs. Anne Pietrusinski directed the program which included dances entitled "Sh Boom," "This Ole House," "Class Waltz," "Charleston," "Me and My Shadow," and a soft shoe dance.

Nineteen fifty-six and the football team was victorious having won the Alle-Kiski championship. Larry Burke and Patricia Blose reigned over a coronation of senior high pageantry in colorful splendor. Routines entitled "Blue Violins," "Surrey With the Fringe

on Top," and "Red Petticoat" were performed to the obvious delight of all.

Nineteen fifty-seven was a special year's end for this year's seniors as it marked the end of our first full school year at Edfra. The royalty on the court of King and Queen John R. Janosky and Donna Hasson were Prince Eugene Brunner, Princess Mary Ann Downard, Duchess Delores Curtis, Duke Terry Serafini, Dorothy Pish, Roberta Morford, Marian Dereani, Gloria Lisko, and Catherine Benecki. This coronation was to be referred to in the yearbook as Mrs. Pietrusinski's Gala Coronation Ball.

In the flurry of glitter and ruffles Frank Girdwood and Polly Ana Sadesky were the reigning couple of 1958. Dennis Harmon and Patricia Olszewski were chosen to serve as prince and princess and duke and duchess were Sandra Klesen and Russell Morgan. "Father of the Bride" was the smash play presented in 1959 with Paul Malobisky in the title role and Inez Branch as the

blushing bride. The seniors elected Danny Ferrari senior king and Mary Lou Kasarda senior queen.

On Friday, May 6, 1960, the 1960 coronation ball was held. The nostalgic theme was "The Beautiful Lady In Blue." Those in attendance that year witnessed the crowning of King Raymond Danik and Queen Barbara Kengor. Little did the classmates of James Modey and James Marelli who graduated that year realize that these two classmates would return to Edfra as teachers

Nineteen sixty-one brought about a totally new senior court. Miss Janet Girdwood and Mr. Kenneth Bracco were queen and king

and the supreme royalty of the year.

During the 1962 coronation the seniors waltzed to "Only You" and witnessed the crowning of Queen Rae Ann Erceg and King

David Stuckley, now also a teacher at Edfen.

On May 4, 1963, a coronation entitled Hawaiian Holiday was presented under the direction of Mrs. Margaret Miles. Seniors Ted Paulovich and Joyce Bowser were crowned king and queen. Edward Cisek, Evelyn Murray, Cheryl Usiadek, and Ralph Kirkbride comprised the remaining royal factors. As an added attraction to the program Joann Pavlik and Cheryl Usiadek sang "Graduation Day."

Nineteen sixty four, when this year's seniors were finishing their first year in high school, another coronation ball was held.

Andrea Brem and Keith Davis were crowned queen and king

In 1965 the coronation ball was held on the seventh day of May. Newly crowned King James Cristillo and Queen Cheryl Onofer were entertained by the "Baby Elephant Walk," "Hullaballoo," "The Cannibals," "Lollypop," and "Washington Square."

In order to celebrate the crowning of Daniel Severa and Kathy Roynak as 1966 royalty the seniors staged their rousing rendition of "Frankie and Johnnie" with Pam Berasi and Dave Bracco. The saloon hostesses included Barbara Kachurik, Shirley Pastorek, and Marsha Duster. Stanley Benecki was the bartender and Terry Ellis, Tom Lesney, Jerry Lojak, and Alan Marcy portrayed the cowboys

The 1967 coronation ball was entitled "Coronation Internationale." Under the direction of Miss Joyce Burkett the dances celebrating the crowning of Queen Sue Huet and King Lawrence Kushner were performed.

Queen Linda Bellinotti and King Daniel Karlo presided over a 1968 coronation full of circus excitement. Rinemaster was Bill York. Routines included a cowboy dance, a sideshow performance, and a carousel.

And finally in 1969 the seniors chose as the final reigning couple of East Deer Miss Jean Pivik and Mr. Robert Greco.

On closing it is apropos to quote from the speech Mr. James E. Clark, former supervising principal presented at the retirement dinner given in his honor. "May we part in person, but ever be with each other in the spirit of trust and love for each other."






