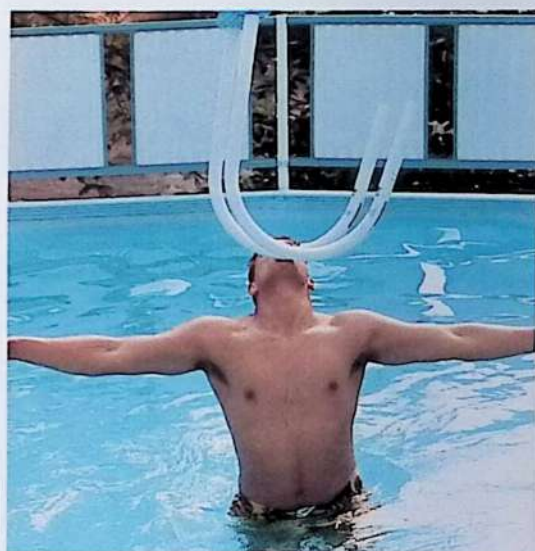
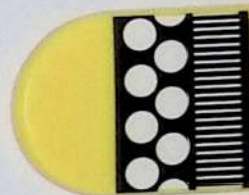
... Not Just Work But Fun

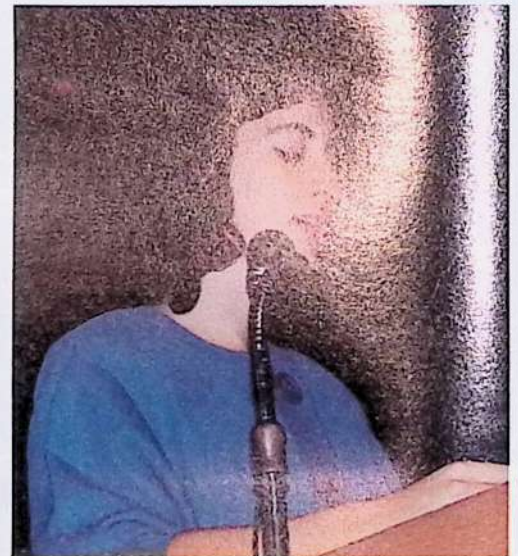

Even though it was not very long, the Homecoming Parade was very enjoyable. It was viewed by many of the Homecoming Court's family and friends.

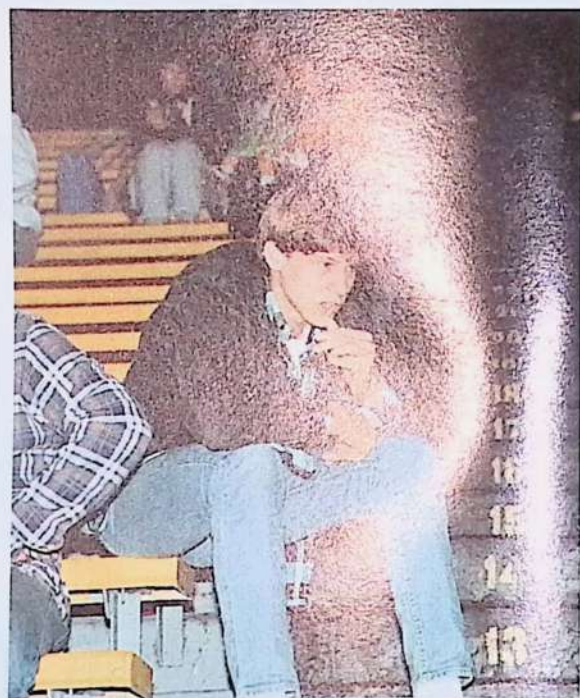
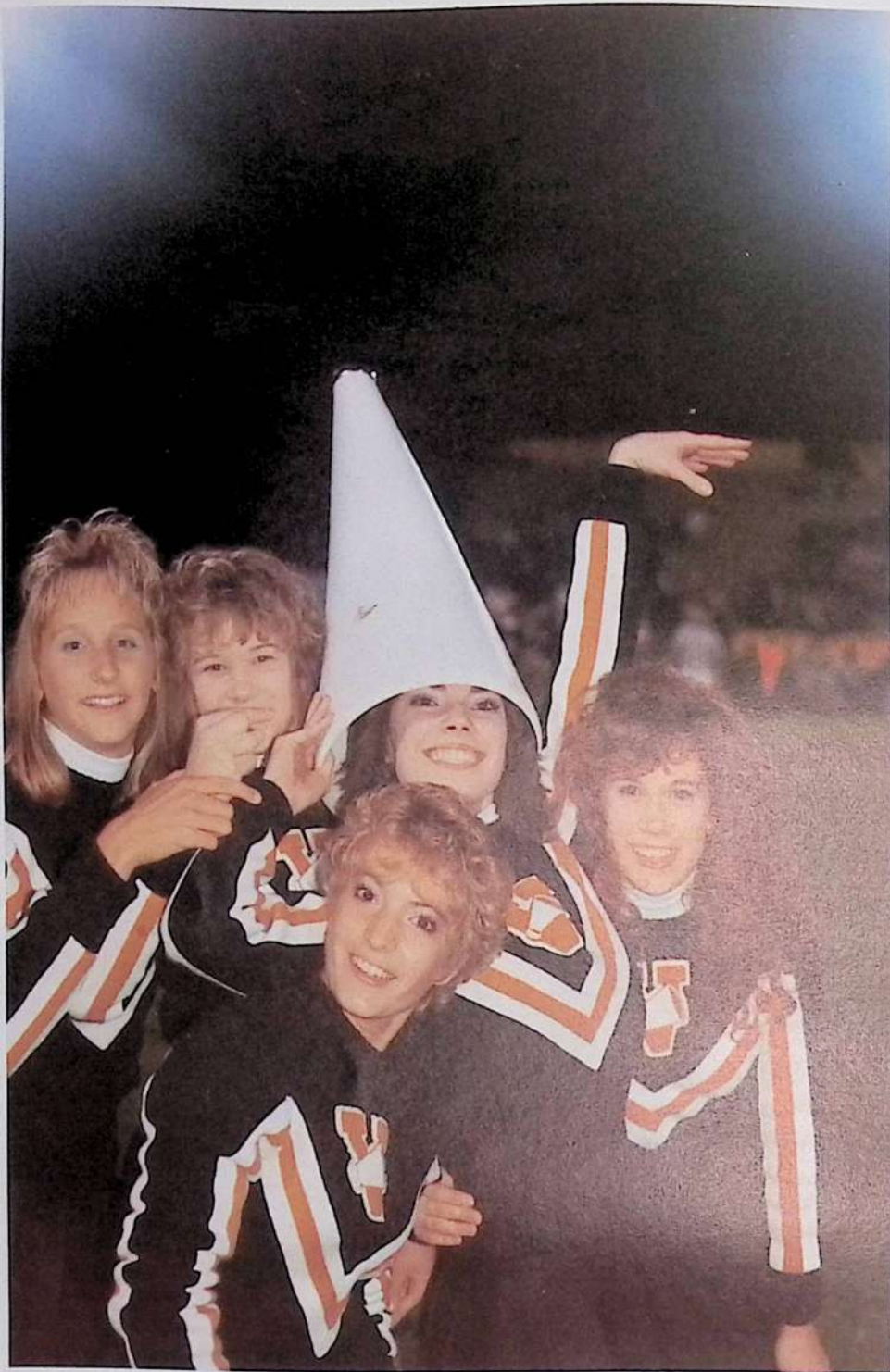

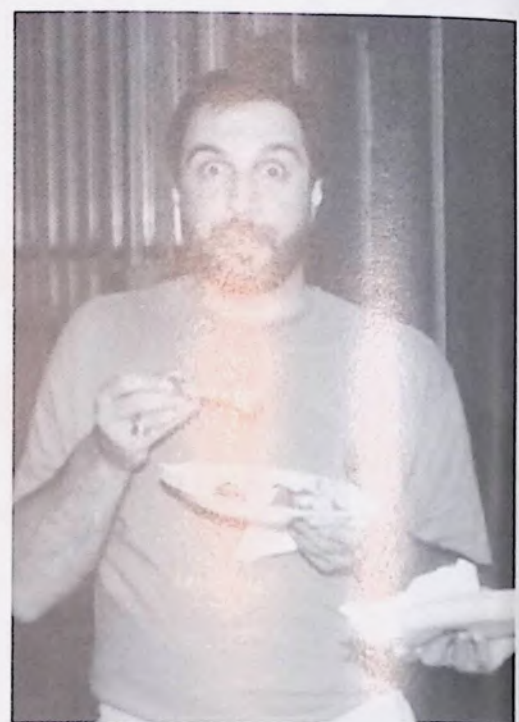


Sophomore Spring Sensation

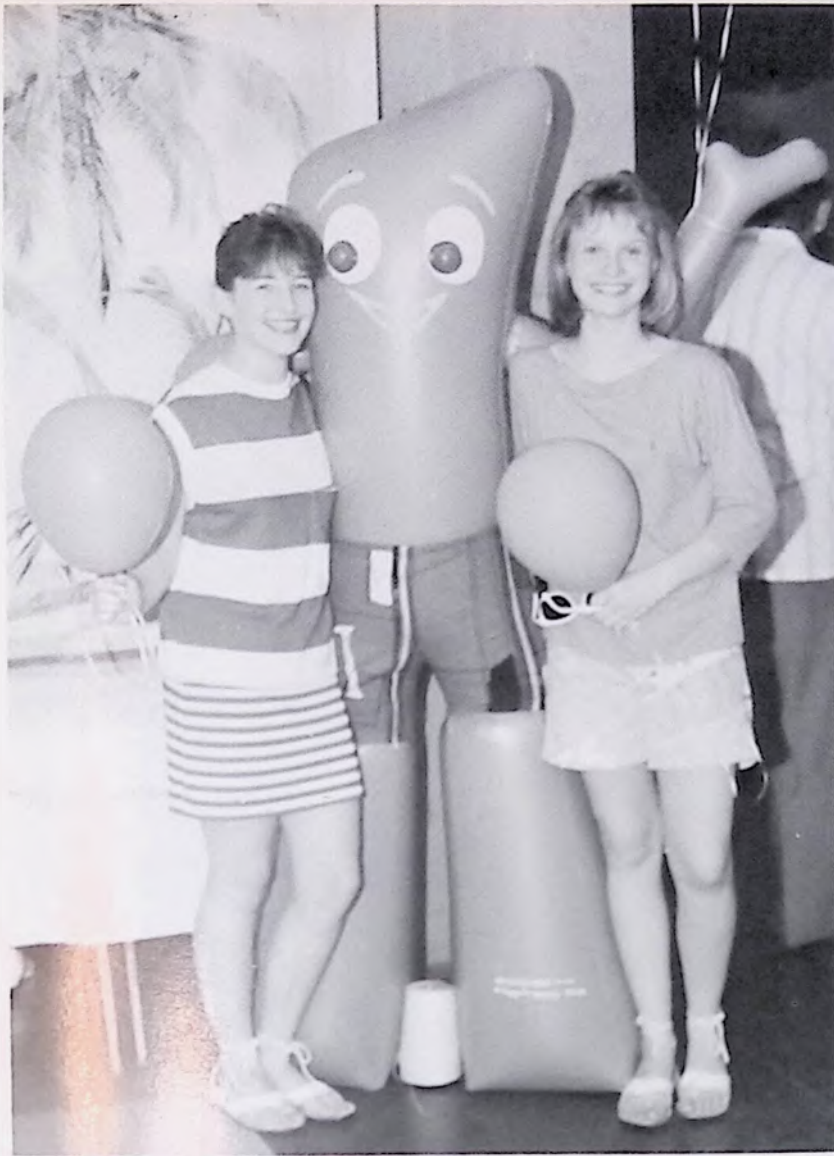






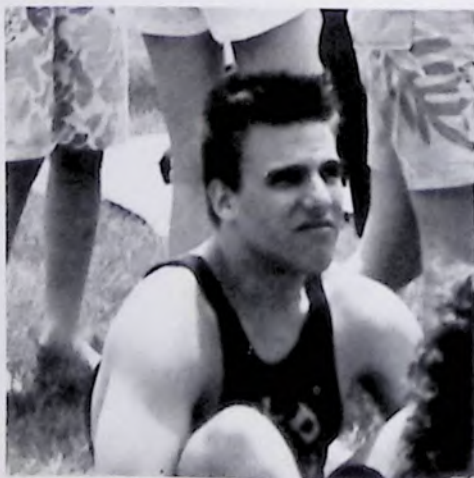
The Freshman Frolic

The stage band is an extension of the concert band. They perform at concerts in late winter and in the spring. They also perform at pep rallies.



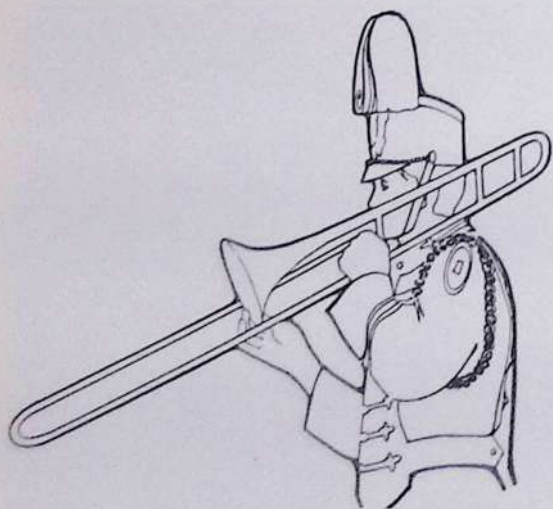

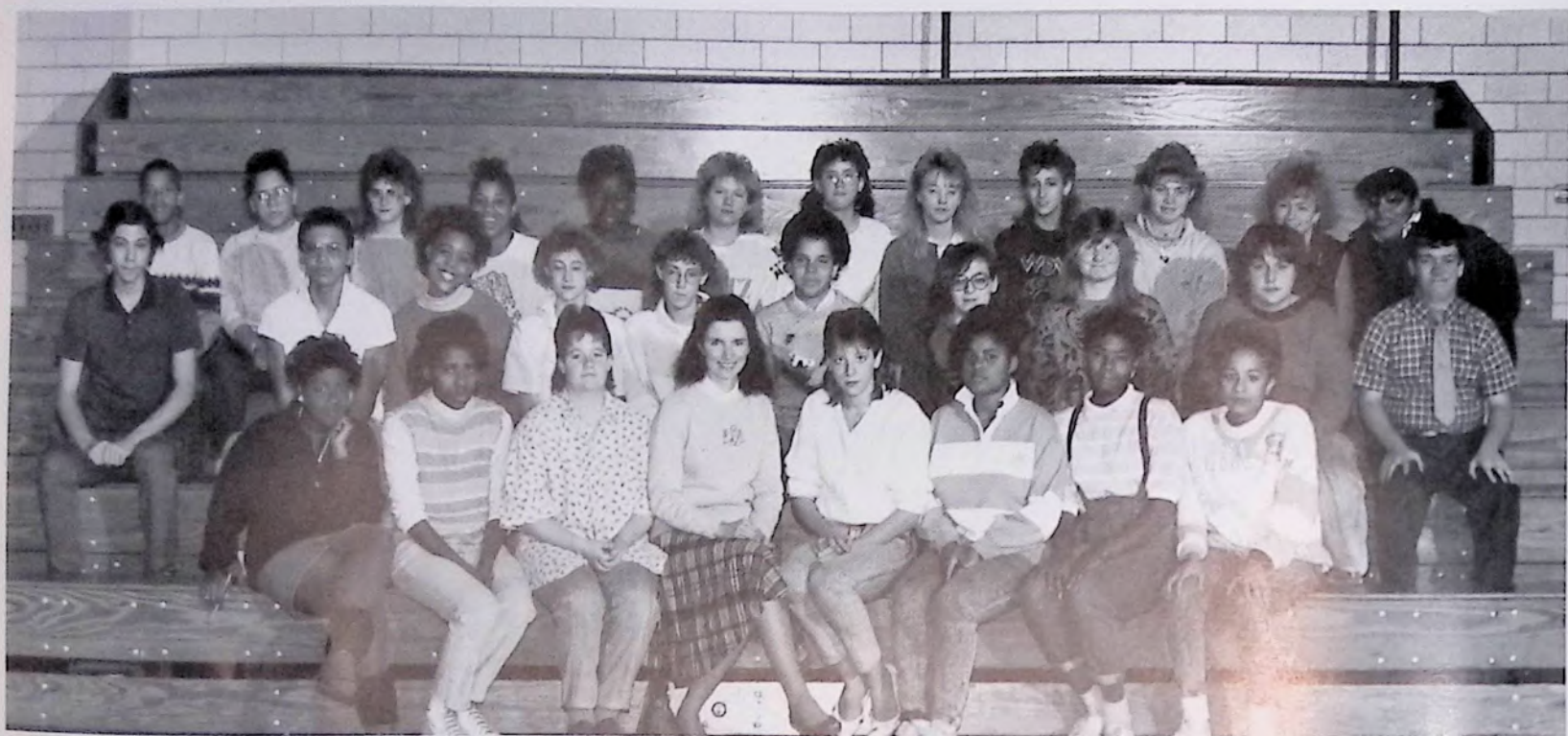


The German Club is a club reborn at Valley High School with the offering of German as an elective course. Mr. Rogusky sponsors this group of students who are interested in learning and using the German Language.

Stepping Through 1987-1988

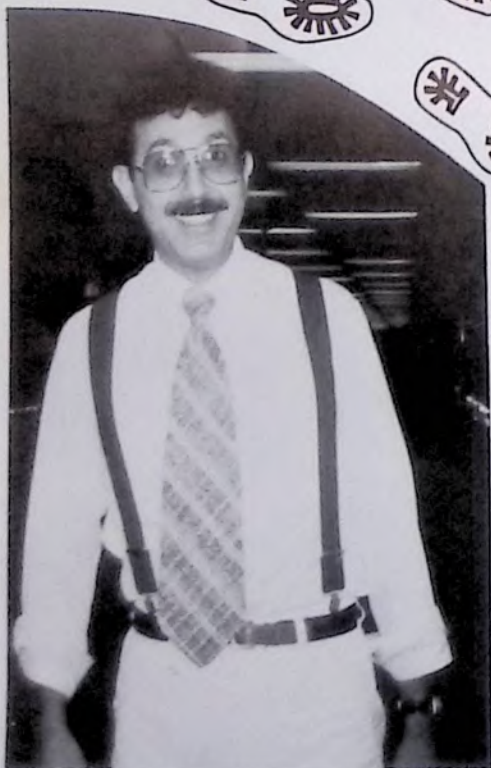


Spring 87

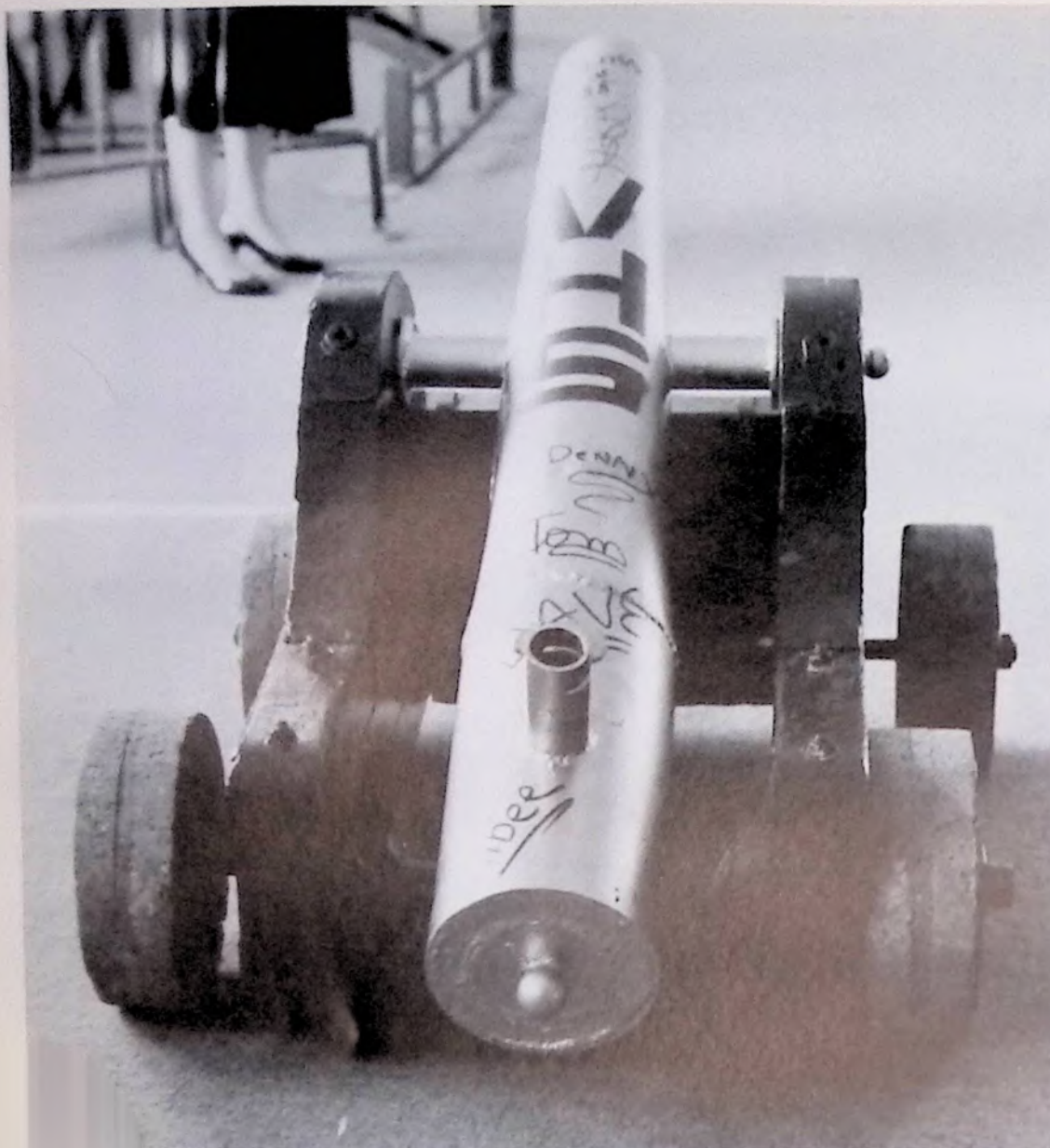
